He was a member of the Class of 1929 at Lincoln Academy and in 1930 attended the Massachusetts Radio School. In 1936 he married Christina C. Reynolds. Maynard was a self-employed farmer and drove a produce truck. He was a longtime employee of the Bath Iron Works, and owned and operated the Albee Gas Station in Wiscasset. Mr. Albee retired from Bath Iron Works in 1973, after 35 years, where he was known as Mr. Republican. He was very active in politics in the town of Alna. Mr. Albee was a member of the Sheepscot Church, a life member of Masonic Lodge #3 in Wiscasset, a Kora Shrine Temple Volunteer, an active member of State Republican Committees and a member of the Lincoln County Draft Board during Vietnam War. He was also a founding member and treasurer of the Alna Fire Department. He was also known as the Mayor of Alna. He was predeceased by his wife of 62 years, Christina C. Albee; one brother, Robert Albee; three sisters, Myra Sewall, Mildred Priest and Evelyn LaVallie. He is survived by two daughters, Judith A. UNITY — Harrison F. Aldrich, D.O., F.A.C.O.F.P., 70, died unexpectedly, Friday Dec. 7, 2001, at St. Joseph Hospital in Bangor.

He was born Jan. 12, 1931, in Worcester, Mass., the son of the late Harold and Helen (Fitch) Aldrich. Harrison went to high school to "play ball." And excel in athletics he did. His talent in track and cross-country led to Yankee Conference titles for four years in a row as well as national titles.

As an indication of Dr. Aldrich's love for sports, he once confessed that at one time his hockey team won a title at 1 p.m., and at 4 p.m. he ran in a track meet and later that evening had a basketball game: "When I got home, my dad said, 'You looked a little tired in the game tonight!' You see, I never told my father what I was doing. He was a checker in that cross-country meet. I was



Dr. Aldrich was a member of many organizations, including the Lions Club and Masonic Order. He served as vice-chairman on the Board of Trustees for Unity College; he was also a cross country coach at Unity College. He was founder and president of the "B.U.M. League," the Pee Wee Basketball Association of Waldo County. He was also a member of the Aircraft Owners & Pilots Association (A.O.P.A.), the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletic Coaches, and the Civil Air Patrol. He was lifetime member of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon, chairman of the Unity Utilities District and a School Board member for SAD 3. Dr. Aldrich also had many memberships in professional organizations, including the American Osteopathic Association, where he served on the Post Doctoral Training Committee, Hospital Inspection Team for Intern Residency Programs, and as a member of the House of Delegates, American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians-Evaluation and Education Committee, Sports Medicine Committee, and an Inspector of General Practice Residencies, Committee on Undergraduate Chapters, Committee on Preceptors Grants, the Membership Committee, American Osteopathic Academy of Sports Medicine Board of Directors, Founder Member, Original Secretary and Treasurer, president-elect, president and fellow; Maine Osteopathic Association-served as president, and a member of the Board of Trustees, House of Delegates, Committee on Osteopathic Structure and Coding, physician representative to Health and Welfare, and on the Legislative Committee; Dr. Aldrich was founder and president on the Maine Osteopathic General Practitioners Association; president of the New England Osteopathic Association, and founder and chairman of the Student Loan Committee; founder and president of the New England Osteopathic General Practitioners

Association; Lung Cancer, Chronic Bronchitis and Emphysema Task Force Committee of Maine; Expanded Child Health Services of Maine, where he served on the Board of Directors. For the University of New England College of Osteopathic Medicine, he served on the faculty as Clinical Associate Professor, on the Dean's Advisory Committee, and served as chairman for the Admission's Committee. For the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, he served as alumni president, and preceptor trainer. Dr. Aldrich was also preceptor trainer for New England College of Osteopathic Medicine, Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine, Michigan State University of Os-

teopathic Medicine, New York College of Osteopathic Medicine, Des Moines College of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery, Kansas City College of Osteopathic Medicine, Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine, and the Squibb Foundation. He had a certificate from the Boxing World Medical Congress; he was a public health officer, Unity; a physician for Unity College and team physician. He was team physician for Robichaud High School in Dearborn, Mich. He was physician for SAD 3 and team physician at Mt. View High School. He was team physician for the Maine Lumberjacks Pro Basketball Team-CBA League and the Maine Windjammers Pro Basketball Team-CBA League, a ringside physician for Professional and Amateur Boxing, and ringside physician for WBC World Championship Boxing.

Dr. Aldrich received numerous awards and citations, which include: Athlete of the Year, UMass, 1954; varsity letter winner, UMass (10 Letters); and captain two years; Man of the Year, Unity College, 1969; an honorary doctor-of-science degree, Unity College; Fellow Award, American College of General Practitioners, 1977. He received the Maine osteopathic profession's highest awards, including: the MOA Ross Bates Memorial Award; General Practitioner of the Year Award-Maine, 1994; and the Distinguished Service Award in 1995.

## Mr. Homer C. Aldrich

NORWAY - Homer C. Aldrich, 91, died Friday, November 22, 1996 at Stephens Memorial Hospital.

He taught electronics at Region 11 from 1978-79.

Mr. Aldrich was a Past Master and 60 Year Member of Oxford Lodge #18, AF & AM; member of the Norway Grange #45; served as a volunteer for the R.S.V.P. and for SCORE; member of the South Paris Historical Society; life member of the Oxford Hills Chamber of Commerce; former member Norway Chapter #168, O.E.S.; formerly active with the Boy

Scouts; formerly active with the United Methodist Church summer camp "Mechuwana" in Winthrop; member of the East Otisfield Free Baptist Church.

Mr. Aldrich received the "Citizen of the Year" award from the Town of Norway in 1983.

Mr. Aldrich was married in Norway on September 28, 1960 to Editha Glover, who survives of Norway. He is also survived by two daughters, Mrs. Murray (Martha) Shaw of Chambersburg, PA, and Mrs. Stanley (Mary) Grover of West Paris; two sons and their wives, Charles and Carol Aldrich of Dixfield and Stephen and Joyce Aldrich of Roxbury; two step-daughters, Mrs. Stanley (Priscilla) Gammon of Stoneham and Mrs. Winnefred Plourde of Auburn; a step-son, Luther Grover of Paris; a step-daughter-in-law, Shirley Grover of South Paris; two sisters, Mrs. Edward (Ismay) Lister of Sanford and Mrs. Eleanor Boyce of Norway; many grandchildren and great-grandchildren; many step-grandchildren and step-great-grandchildren; and one great-great-granddaughter. Mr. Aldrich was predeceased by a daughter, Joyce Sampson, and two brothers, Kenneth and Rupert Aldrich.
