## optometrist, artist, Acton planner

ACTON - Dr. David Winslow Bartlett, 73, of Hopper Road, a third-generation optometrist and 17-year member of the local Planning Board, died Finday at his home after a long illness.

Dr. Bartlett was born in Boston, Mass., a son of Howard and Marian Adwers Bartlett.

He lived in Newton Center and Wellesley Hills, and

graduated from New Hampton Prep in New Hampton, N.H. He also attended Tufts University.

He served in the Air Force in Cuba and England in World War II, and returned to earn his doctor of osteopathy degree from Northem Illinois College of Optometry in 1948.

He began practicing optometry in 1952 with his father at Bartlett and Son Optical in Boston, later moving to Brookline and

Hingham, Mass. In 1972, he moved to Sanford where he ran his own practice until retiring in 1989.

Along with his wife, Jeanne Erhardt Bartlett, he owned Tamarack Rabbitry at Tamarack Farm, where they raised angora rabbits and Christmas trees.

"When people used to call us and ask for directions to the rabbit farm, they used to ask us 'Are you really on Hopper Road?" and we'd say, 'Yes, we really are," recalled Mrs. Bartlett.

The Bardetis moved to the farm, which had been in her husband's family since the 1930s, in 1972, Mrs. Bardett said. Before raising rabbits and trees, they bred goats, and were once featured in an article in the Wall Street Journal, she isaid.
