

Mrs. Caldwell was born in Deer River, a daughter Edward and Helen Churchill Donahue, and attended Kingfie schools and Farmington Normal School.

She taught school for five years in Flagstaff and at t former Black Schoolhouse in Eustis. After that, she w a housewife and enjoyed flower gardening, knitting, crocheting sewing and braiding rugs.

Mrs. Caldwell was a past matron and member of tl Stratton Order of the Eastern Star of Stratton, receivir her 50-year pin, a member of the Congregational Church and the PTA.

Born in Eustis, Mr. Caldwell was a son of Leslie an Lillian Fletcher Caldwell, and he attended schools ther. He was a 45-year member of the Mount Bigelow Lodg of Masons, and a former member of the Stratton Congrega tional Church.

The Caldwells are survived by four sons, Jesse c Thorndike, Ernest A. Jr. and John, both of Stratton, an Frank of West Baldwin; a daughter, Sibyl Stevens o Stratton; 21 grandchildren, 23 great-grandchildren and tw great-great-grandchildren. Mr. Caldwell is also survived by three sisters, Reta Everett of Stratton and Jessie Emerson an Lillian Heath, both of Concord, N.H. Mrs. Caldwell is survivee by two sisters, Helen Pulsifer of Spruce Head and Ruth Batt o Sonoma, Calif.

Another son, Harold Caldwell, died in 1986.

Mr. Caldwell's funeral was held Friday at Adams Funeral Home in Farmington. The Rev. James Downey officiated. A funeral for Mrs. Caldwell will be held in the spring at Flagstaff Memorial Chapel, Eustis. The couple will be buried in Upper Cemetery in the spring.
