# U. Of M. Professor Dies Suddenly

**C. W. T. Chapman**  
**Native Of Porter**

Orono, May 6—Chauncey W. L. Chapman, 53, assistant professor of forestry at the University of Maine, died suddenly, today at his home, 13 Park Street.

Professor Chapman left his teaching duties at the university shortly before noon feeling ill and died of a heart ailment 15 minutes after he arrived home.

Born at Porter, Me., May 20, 1893, Professor Chapman passed much of his early life at Porter and Kezar Falls.

He later became a student at the University of Maine and was gradu-

ated in the class of 1914. While a student at the university, he became a member of the Delta Tau Delta fraternity and a member of the Scabbard and Blade.

Professor Chapman served in the first World War and held a reserve commission with the rank of major. His age prevented him from service in the second World War.

He joined the faculty of the University of Maine in the Fall of 1919 and won his master's degree in forestry in 1921 and only recently celebrated his 25th anniversary of service to the university.

He was a Mason and a member of the American Legion.

He is survived by his widow, Mildred Lombard Chapman; twin daughters, Mary Joan and Mildred Lombard, all of Orono.

Funeral services will be held in Fellowship Church, Orono at 9 a. m. Thursday, with interment in the family lot at Bridgton.
