Former Portland Municipal Court Judge and Recorder Wilford G. Chapman Jr., 65, died suddenly yesterday at his home at 1662 Forest Ave.

Mr. Chapman, who headed the law firm of Chapman and Chapman with his brother, Clark D. Chapman, for more than 40 years, was born in Portland July 24, 1890, son of Wilford G. and Tinnie A. D. Chapman. His father was a former mayor of Portland.



He was born in Augusta, the son of Edward and




He was predeceased by his parents and a brother, Gerald Chaput.
