Funeral services for Isaac A. Clough, 84, of 315 Woodford Street, many years employed by the Gannett Publishing Company, Inc., before he retired, were held this afternoon in the Chapel of James A. Charles E. Cobb, 76, of Denmark, pioneer operator of summer camps for boys and girls and a former member of the Legislature, died Friday at his Winter home in Vero Beach, Fla., according to word received here Saturday.

Mr. Cobb was born at Limerick Oct. 20, 1866, the son of Moses L. and Elizabeth H. Cobb, and was educated at Limerick Academy, the Moses Brown School in Providence, R. I., Shaw's Business College in Portland and Harvard University summer school.

SOUTH PORTLAND — Daniel P. Cobb, who was 106 years old Aug. 17, died this morning in a local nursing home. He was the oldest living Mason in the United States, the oldest resident of South Portland and probably the oldest citizen of Maine.

He was a member of Hiram Lodge, AF & AM, South Portland.

His birthday, August 17, was proclaimed Daniel Cobb Day last year by the South Portland City Council.

His wife, the former Jenny Blenn, died in 1961.

Mr. Cobb also was a timber operator and has several sawmills which provided spars for navigation buoys. He also built seven houses.

In the 1930s he grew broad leaf tobacco near Willard Beach. His love for tobacco never diminished as he said four years ago that he had always smoked and still smoked three or four cigars a day.



Daniel P. Cobb

was an alderman in that city from 1914 to 1916.

Mr. Cobb remained active, despite his retirement, and voted in the Presidential election last year and served as grand marshal of South Portland's 75th anniversary parade last July.
