
prographic Association.

Charles E. Cobb, 76, of Denmark, pibneer operator of summer camps for boys and girls and a former member of the Legislature, died Friday at his Winter home in Vero Beach, Flat, according to word re-

ceived here Saturday.

Mr. Cobb was born at Limerick Oct. 20, 1866, the son of Moses L. and Elizabeth H. Cobb, and was educated at Limerick Academy, the Moses Brown School in Providence, R. I., Shaw's Business College in Portland and Harvard University summer school.

Daniel P. Cobb Dead At 106

SOUTH PORTLAND - Daniel P. Cobb, who was 106 years old Aug. 17, died this morning in a local nursing home. He was the oldest living Mason in the United States, the oldest resident of South Portland and probably the oldest citizen of Maine.

Mr. Cobb, who had made his home with his daughter, Mrs. Clayton LaForge, 21 Ridge Road, Cape Elizabeth, retired about 10 years ago after operating a florist shop and greenhouse at 450 Preble St. for many years. He also had operated a farm in Cape Elizabeth and was the first farmer in the area to grow iceberg lettuce.

He graduated from Cape Elizabeth High School in 1884, when South Portland was still part of Cape Elizabeth. He was the last living charter member of the Willard Engine and Ladder Co., was a former postmaster of South Portland and

was an alderman in that city seven houses. from 1914 to 1916.


