Biddeford, Dec. 3.—Abraham L. T. Cummings, 86, former secretary-manager of the Maine State Chamber of Commerce and Portland city clerk, died today in a Saco convalescent home.

Mr. Cummings was a former editor of the Biddeford Daily and Weekly Times and served as alderman here in 1893. For five years he taught journalism and was agricultural editor at the University of Maine.

Mr. Cummings was born at Saco, Feb. 13, 1865, the son of John G. and Theodate Tasker Cummings. He attended Saco schools and moved to Portland in

1894 when he gave up the Biddeford editorship to become Western Maine representative of the Boston Herald. He was the author of several magazine articles and reported for the Associated Press while in Biddeford. He also was Sunday editor of

He was a charter member of the Portland Rotary Club, a 32nd Degree Mason and an honorary deacon of the Second Congregational Church of Biddeford.

A summer resident of Buxton Lower Center, Mr. Cummings became friends with author Kate Douglas Wiggin of that town, who interested him in playing the leading role of Justin in the stage production of her story, The Old Peabody Pew. He played this part for more than 13 years at Buxton.

His last employment was with the York Mutual Fire Insurance Company, which has an office at Bar Mills.

For the past ten years he has resided here with his widow, the former Angie F. Norton of Biddeford, and her sister. Also surviving are a brother, John E. Cummings, DD; a sister Mrs. Mark Proctor, and several nieces and nephews.

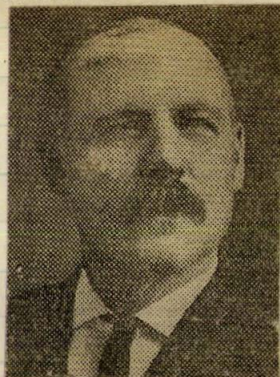
