A daughter, Michelle Mary Cummings Clay, died in 1975.

Leland C. of Jacksonville, N.C.; a brother, Russell J. of

Plymouth, Mass.; and two grandchildren.

William H. Cumming

honored as pharmacist, weather observer

HOULTON - William H. Cumming, 102, of Elm Street died Wednesday at his residence. He was the father of Alexander Cumming of Saco.

Born in Sherbrooke, Quebec, a son of Alexander and Maud (Jordan) Cumming, he moved to Houlton in 1894. He attended Houlton schools and the former Ricker

Classical Institute there.

At the age of 18, he started work at the S.L. White Drug Store and a year later, moved to Munro's Drug Store. In June of 1914 he became a registered pharmacist at age 21, then the youngest in the state.

He was a member of the 2nd Maine Infantry for three

years where he was a qualified sharpshooter.

He was employed at O.F. French Drug Store from 1938 to 1944, when he bought out the Munro Drug Store and opened the West End Drug Store. In 1968 he sold the store to Plaza Pharmacy, where he continued to work until he retired in 1972 at the age of 80. He worked for 62 years in the oharmaceutical field.

He was the oldest living member of the First Baptist Church of Houlton, where he served as deacon and

taught Sunday school for years.

Mr. Cumming was a cooperative weather observer for which he received John Campanius Holm awards in 1964 and 1972 and the National Weather Service Edward H. Stoll Award in 1985 for 50 years of service.

He was a 75-year member of the Monument Lodge of Masons and a licensed ham radio operator (WINSN) for 55 years. On Sept. 12, 1978, he received the Thomas Jefferson Award. He also was honored with awards from the Aroostook Pharmaceutics! Association in 1964, the Houlton Chamber of Commerce in 1976 and a Community Citizen Award in 1981 from the Houlton Grange.

His wife of 50 years, Margaret (Martin) Cumming and his daughter, Edith L. Cumming, both died previously.

Surviving are a son, Alexander of Saco; a daughter, Lois J. Cumming of Houlton; four grandchildren, Bruce G. Cumming of Chelmsford, Mass., Bonnie Dalton of Morrill, Janet and Bruce Ticker of Alfred, and Susan and Ronald Fortucci of Easton, Md.; and four great-grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the First Baptist Church with the Rev. Burton Hoyt officiating. Burial will be in the Evergreen Cemetery. Arrangements

ORONO - George Snowdeal Cunningham, 84, husband of the late Eve-Ivn L. (Cole) Cunningham, died Dec. 19, 1993, at a Bangar hospital. He was born in Whitefield, Morch 25, 1909, the son of Warren E. and Ella (Snowdeal) Cunningham. He was Professor Emeritus from the University of Maine, Orono, who earned his BA and MEd from the University of Maine and completed post-masters work at both Boston University and Harvard College. His enrollment in Anah Shriners was recorded as August 11, 1950.




