He was born at Wakefield, Mass., Dec. 12, 1913, the son of Charles Herbert and Stella Hawes Cutter. He graduated from Wakefield High School and in 1934 graduated from Massachusetts Maritime Academy.

The news of the sudden death of Harold Edmund Cutting, early Monday morning at his home 23 Bath street, comes as a shock to his hosts of friends.

He was one of the highest ranking Masons in the city and in the State,—he was past master of Polar Star Lodge, F. & A.M. having served in 1925. He was a past High Priest of Montgomery and St. Bernard Royal Arch Chapter, past commander of Dunlap Commandery, and a member of the Shrine of Kora Temple in Lewiston. He was also the present worthy patron of Genesta Chapter, O.E.S. and had served in the same capacity in 1940-1941. Of late he has been serving with his daughter, Martha Cutting Bertrand, the worthy matron of the chapter.

Mr. Cutting was also a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Mt. Vernon Council of Brunswick, and was a member of the uniformed bodies of the Shrine of Kora Temple, where at the time of his death he was treasurer.

He was also a member of Central Congregational Church and of the Men's Club.

Mr. Cutting was a baseball enthusiast and for 30 years played amateur ball; he never lost his interest in the sport. He was interested in music and for 30 years played in various Bath bands as trombonist.

He was born in Lewiston, Nov. 8, 1889, son of George F. and Sarah (Williams) Cutting, and when a small child moved with his family to Bangor, where he received his education in the public schools.

He entered the employ of the Hyde Windlass Co. in 1909, where he learned his trade of machinist, but for several years has been shipping clerk with the company. There was no more popular employe in the company than "Dido" as he was known by his hosts of friends. He came to Bath 41 years ago.

Mr. Cutting married Marguerite Rullman of this city who survives, as do three daughters, Mrs. Annette Scott of Cambridge, Mass., Mrs. Martha Bertrand of this city, and Mrs. Mildred McCall of Argus, Ind., and five grandchildren.

Mr. Cutting will be greatly missed at Masonic Temple where he took an active part in all of its doing both in Masonic circles as well as in Genesta Chapter activities.

Mr. Cutting has added much during the past years to the entertainment of the public in his brother acts with Herbert Douglas of this city. They have been end men in numberless minstrel shows and were known as the popular "Herbie Douglas and Dido Cutting" team.

Funeral services will be Thursday afternoon at two o'clock from the Curtis Funeral Home, 942 Washington street, when a commandery service will be held.
