Howard H. Davis, 41, of 125 Ocean Avenue, died early Friday evening in a local hospital, shortly after drinking poison.

Davis' wife, Mrs. Marion Davis, told police that her husband gasped to her that he had taken the poison just before he was rushed to the hospital. She tried to get him to drink warm water, she said, the antidote directed on the poison bottle, but he was unable to.

She told police that he had been trying unsuccessfully to sell refrigeration equipment for five weeks.

Dr. Joseph E. Porter, county medical examiner, said he would examine the body this morning to determine the cause of death.

Mrs. Davis said she was out when her husband came home, and when she returned, shortly after 6 p. m. she found him in agony.

Hospital attaches said that the poison is available commercially as an insect spray.

Davis was born Aug. 21, 1908 in Portland, son of the late Clifton L. and Edith Hussey Davis.

He attended South Portland High School and Hebron Academy and was graduated from Burdette College, Boston. He was a member of Hiram Lodge of Masons, South Portland.

Surviving, besides his widow, are his mother and two sons, Clifton, 12, and Theodore, 11.

Laurence I. Davis

Edgcomb town clerk for 40 years

EDGECOMB - Laurence I. Davis, 81, longtime Edgcomb town clerk and proprietor of Davis Brothers Cabins, died here Wednesday.

Mr. Davis, of Old Fort Road, lived all his life on Davis Island, which is in the Sheepscot River where Route 1 crosses from Wiscasset to Edgcomb. He was a direct descendant of Moses Davis, who settled the island in 1770.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Davis and his father, Irving L., used to own more than half the 80-acre island. For 50 years they had a family business, Davis Brothers Cabins on the shore of the Sheepscot just off Route 1. That business was started by his father in 1926 as a filling station with tenting sites. His father died in 1960 and Mr. Davis ran the cabins until his retirement in 1976.

His elected position as Edgcomb's town clerk lasted for more than 40 years. He served part time with an office in his home.

"They came to his house at all times of day and night for things like fishing licenses," said Jim Hall, a lifelong friend.

"He had a wonderful mind," said Edward Naus, a longtime friend. "He could tell you all the history of everybody in Edgcomb. He could tell dates and everything. His father was the town clerk before him."

When Mr. Davis gave up the job as clerk a few years ago, the office was moved for the first time into the Town Hall.

In recent years he enjoyed hiking and fishing in Baxter State Park. "He climbed Mt. Katahdin for the first time when he was 60 years old," said Hall. "He climbed it about three times after that."

Born in Edgcomb, a son of Irving L. and Mable C. Decker Davis, he graduated in 1932 from Wiscasset Academy. He was active for many years in the alumni association of Wiscasset Academy.

During World War II, he served in the Army Air Forces in Europe.

An active member of the Masons, he was a past master of the Lincoln Lodge of Masons, past secretary of New Jerusalem of Wiscasset, a past district deputy grand master of Lincoln Royal Arch Chapter of Damariscotta, a past patron of the Garrison Hill Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star, a charter member and first director from Edgcomb of the Lincoln County Cultural and Historical Assoc., and a member of the Bradford-Scottwell-Wright American Legion.

Mr. Davis was an organist, treasurer and deacon of the Edgcomb Congregational Church, a past master of the Edgcomb Grange and a member of the Huntoon Hill Grange.

Surviving are seven cousins, Decker Patterson of Washington, D.C., Nancy Bradstreet of Ipswich, Mass., Virginia Dow Wallace of Davenport, Fla., Paul Davis and Robert Davis, Jr., both of South China, Priscilla Davis Boggs and Beverly Davis of California.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at Edgcomb Congregational Church. Burial will be in the spring in North Edgcomb Cemetery. Arrangements are by Mayo Funeral Home, Wiscasset.

He was predeceased by his mother in June of 1997.
