## SYLVANUS S. DAVIS

PRESQUE ISLE — Sylvanus S. Davis, 91, died Sept. 28, 1996, at a Presque Isle health-care facility. He was born June 14, 1905, at Caribou, the son of James W. and Rosinia (Steven) Davis. After graduating from Presque Isle High School and attending the Aroostook Normal School for one year, he was employed by the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad and later the U.S. Border Patrol until 1943. 
