Arno N. Day fourth-generation boatbuilder

SEDGWICK - Arno Nevells Day, 81, a lifelong boatbuilder who lectured and taught the art of building wooden boats, died unexpectedly here Thursday.

A fourth-generation boatbuilder, Mr. Day was best known as a designer and builder of wooden lobster boats. He owned his own boatyard and before that he worked at various local yards.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"His life's work, if you will, were lobster boats in the 30- to 35-foot range," said his son, James Day, also a boatbuilder. "They evolved over the years. There was a series of 35-foot lobster boats he built in the early 1970s that, if you asked him, he'd say they were the ones he was most proud of."

Mr. Day's boat designs have been built around the world, and several of his Maine lobster boats were made in Seattle and used as pleasure

boats. "They're a little different than they're used to out there, so they seemed to catch on," said his son.

Mr. Day learned his trade as a boy, hanging around his grandfather's boat shop. He went into business with his brother and father in Brooklin, and they also built military patrol boats in Stonington during World War II.

He tried to get into the service during the war, but was given an exclusion because the government felt he was more valuable building boats.

After the war, he found his niche designing and building commercial lobster boats.

"He loved wooden boats," said his son. "That's what he lived for."

Mr. Day retired about 10 years ago, but continued to teach and do design work. He shared his passion for boats with students at Deer Isle-Stonington High School, Woodenboat School, Penobscot Marine Museum, Maine Maritime Museum, Maine Maritime Academy and Eastern Maine Vocational Technical Institute. Many private projects also came under his tutelage. He was a well-known lecturer on the evolution of the Maine lobster boat and freely shared his wealth of knowledge in order to perpetuate his craft.

"He just gave of himself to the young people who were interested in the same thing," said his sister, Mary E. Hawkins.

In May, the Maine Maritime Academy conferred upon him an honorary doctor of science degree.

Mr. Day served 25 years on the Brooklin and SAD 73 school boards, and was also a Brooklin selectman. He was a 50-year member of Brooklin Odd Fellows and Center Harbor Rebekah Lodge, and active in the Masons.

Born in Sedgwick, a son of Frank L. and Myrtle Nevells Day, he graduated as valedictorian of Brooklin High School in 1935. He attended Colby College from 1935-37.

Surviving are his wife of 58 years, Dorothy L. Butler Day; two sons, Stephen E. of Santa Fe, N.M., and James A. of New Brunswick; two daughters, Lois Washburn of Hooksett, N.H., and Mary Colcord of Barrington, N.H.; a brother, Frank L. of Brooklin; a sister, Mary E. Hawkins of Camden; 10 grandchildren and a great-granddaughter.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday at Brooklin Baptist Church. The Rev. James Lufkin will officiate. Arrangements are by Healey Funeral Home, Blue Hill.

Charles Albert Day, whose death occurred early Monday morning, at the Memorial Hospital at Damariscotta, was buried Wednesday in the cemetery at North Edgecomb. Funeral services were held in the North Edgecomb Congregational Church, the officiation ministers being the Rev. William K. Houghton, Mr. Day's pastor, and the Rev. Clifford Wesley Collins, nephew of Mr. Day and minister of the Congregational Church at Plainfield, N. J. The pallbearers were Walter T. Greenleaf, Irving L. Davis, Harry O. Carlisle, and Thomas A. Hutchins.

Mr. Day was born Sept. 15, 1867, at Damariscotta, the son of Joseph and Mary J. Day. He spent his boyhood in Damariscotta, attending Lincoln Academy, and started his business career as an apprentice to John L. Clifford in the hardware business. Later he was connected for a number of years with the Emery-Waterhouse Company of Portland, going from there to New York from which center he traveled through the South and West for several years. CHARLES E. DAY

1928-2002

LEWISTON — Charles E. Day, 73, of 17 Bristol Road, Lewiston, died suddenly on Wednesday, Oct. 9, at the Central Maine Medical Center.

Born in Roxbury, Mass., on Oct. 16, 1928, he was the son of Israel and Frances Goldberg Day. He moved to Auburn at the age of nine and was educated in local schools, graduating from Edward Little High School in 1945.

He entered the University of Maine, Orono, then left in order to serve in the U.S. Army as a medic in post-war Germany for two years, then went back to the university, graduating in 1949 with a degree in Business Administration.

On June 26, 1949, he was married to the former Sylvia Benson. A well respected businessman and developer, Mr. Day has a long history of achievements, including becoming president and director in 1954 of the Benson & Sullivan Co., a wholesale distributor throughout Maine and northern New Hampshire, founding National Vending Co. in 1955, and in 1959 he founded Value House, with its first catalog showroom in Lewiston.

In a decade he had opened a total of 20 showrooms throughout New England, New York, and New Jersey, and in 1971 he sold the chain to Supermarket General Corp.

In 1974 he moved to Florida, and while living there founded several companies, including International Contracting Co., a jewelry manufacturing plant in Puerto Rico, The Jewelry

Factory, a retail jewelry company in Ft. Lauderdale, and The Price Jewelers in Orlando, later adding stores in Virginia, Philadelphia, and the Washington, D.C. area.

In 1983 he became the president of Lewiston Raceways, Inc., closing the track in 1990 and developing the area with his son James and daughter Jayne, and returned to Maine as a permanent resident in 1996. Mr. Day has served as President and Chair of the Board for Central Maine Medical Center, and as President of the Beth Jacob Synagogue.

He also served as President of the Florida Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association; as national treasurer of Harness Horse International, the National Association for Owners and Horsemen and Women; and was inducted into the New England Harness Writers Hall of Fame in 1987, after owning six world champions and many other great racing horses.

A member of the Temple Beth Synagogue, he is survived by his loving wife of 53-years, Sylvia Benson Day of Lewiston; two sons, John and wife Shelley of North Dartmouth, Mass., and James and wife Filomena of Lewiston; a daughter, Jayne and husband Gregory Thornton of Falmouth; two brothers, Melvin S. Day of Washington, D.C., and Donald S. Day of Buffalo, N.Y.; and five grandchildren, Jeff and Julie Day, Nicholas and Elizabeth Thornton, and Jillian Day.

Wiscasset, Nov. 28. — Horace Wesley Day, 38-year-old Wiscasset hardware store proprietor, was killed in his car while returning from a Thanksgiving Day visit this afternoon by a bullet which apparently came from a hunter's rifle.

The fatal shooting occurred on Route 27 near Race's Filling Station, about a mile west of Wiscasset Village, as Mr. and Mrs. Day and their two-year-old son, Wesley R., were returning from Edgecomb.

Medical Examiner Philip Greg-

ory said Day, who was driving the car, a light pick-up truck, was hit over the left eye and that death was instantaneous.

After the bullet crashed through the car and hit her husband, Mrs. Day turned off the ignition switch and applied the emergency brake. The vehicle grated against a highway fence for about 150 yards before coming to a stop, but neither Mrs. Day nor the child was injured.

The family was returning from a holiday celebration at the home of Mrs. Day's father, Mel Greenleaf, Edgecomb.

Lincoln County Sheriff Herbert L. Pinkham said tonight that several hunters known to have been in the vicinity were being questioned. The bullet which claimed Day's life was found on the floor of his car, Pinkham said and the rifles of several of the hunters are being held for ballistics tests.

The hunters, some residents of Maine and others from out of state, "are all being very cooperative with investigating officials," Pinkham added.

Day, who had been a resident of Wiscasset since 1934, was graduated from Norway High School and Bay Path Institute, Springfield, Mass. He was a member of the Wiscasset Masonic Lodge and a charter member of the Wiscasset Lions Club organized last week.

Surviving, besides his widow and son, is his father, Wesley C. Day, manager of the Wiscasset branch of the Depositors Trust Company.
