CALAIS and EASTPORT - Clarence C. Dearborn, 88, died March 6, 1992, at a Bangor hospital. He was born July 25, 1903, at Corinna, the son of Clarence L. and Alamanda (Lary) Dearborn. He was a graduate of the Corinna Union Academy, Class of 1921, and the Gilman Commercial College of Bangor. During World War II he was employed by the U.S. Customs Service and afterward, for 21 years, with the Maine State Liquor Commission, retiring as manager of the Eastport Liquor Store, in 1973. He then moved to Calais and was employed at King's Department Store for 8 1/2 years, until his permanent retirement in 1981. He was received into the masonic fraternity on February 14, 1929, with the Rising Virtue Lodge No. 10 of Bangor, where he remained a member for 25 years, before transferring to the Eastern Lodge No. 7, Eastport. He became the worshipful master in 1960 and was a member of the Past Masters Association of the Second Masonic District. In 1947, he became a member of Eastern Chapter No. 10 R.A.M. of Eastport and was its most excellent high priest in 1956. He became a member of the Maine

Council Order of High Priesthood and was a grand steward of the Grand Chapter of Maine in 1958. In 1951, he joined St. Croix Council No. 11, Royal and Select Masters and in 1960 became its illustrious master. He received the grade of thrice illustrious master in the Maine Council of Thrice Illustrious Masters in 1966, as a charter member. He became a Knights Templar in St. Bernard Commandery No. 11 and was its eminent commander in 1952 and several times afterward. He was also a member of the Past Commanders Association of Maine. He affiliated with St. Croix Chapter No. 17 R.A.M. of Calais in 1973 and the Hugh de Paynes Commandery No. 15 of Calais in 1980. He became a member of Magii Chapter No. 100 O.E.S. and became its worthy patron in 1962, for a period of nine years. In 1977, he affiliated with Orion Chapter No. 45 O.E.S. of Calais. He was a member of Chalcedon Conclave No. 5 of the Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine of Saco and a member of the Past Officers Association No. 1 of Maine. He was a member and for five years a trustee of the United

Methodist Church of Calais. He is survived by his wife, Dorothy Theriault Dearborn of Calais; one daughter, Mrs. Lawrence (Gale) Parker of Eastport; one sister Miss Sadie Dearborn of Kittery; two brothers, Walter of Dexter and Willard of Bangor; three grandchildren, three great-grandchildren, several nieces and nephews. He is also survived by two stepchildren, Gerald Spaulding of California and Patricia Ramsdell of Calais; several stepgrandchildren and step great-grandchildren. Friends may call 2-4 and 7-9 p.m. Monday at the Scott-Wilson Funeral Home in Calais, where a Masonic memorial services will be conducted at 8 p.m. Funeral services will be conducted by the Rev. Wayne McDonald 1 p.m. Tuesday at the United Methodist Church of Calais. Burial will take place in the spring in Eastport. He worked briefly in the office of the Maine Planning Board.

During the 1930s, he owned and operated Leighton Drugstore in Portland.

"In those days, you didn't have to be a licensed pharmacist," said his daughter, Carol L. Benny of Windham. "He made up the prescriptions, but he had to pay much higher insurance because he didn't have the (pharmacist's) license."

Mr. Dearborn later worked as an accountant

for Baker Refrigeration in South Portland.

In the late 1940s, he joined the sales staff of the A.H. Benoit clothing store in Portland. Mr. Dearborn worked there for 28 years and retired in 1976.

He also served as a part-time deputy in the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office.

Mr. Dearborn was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, Windham Ward.

He was active in church affairs, and spent much time organizing the church's genealogical library.

"Mr. Dearborn was a worthy church member," said Bishop Jonathon Miele, pastor of the Windham church.

"He was one of the first ones you saw when you arrived at church, and he was always there with a handshake and a smile."

His daughter said he was interested in the genealogy of his family as well as that of church members.

"He had traced his family back until about 1642, when they came to this country from England," she said.

"He was a great reader, and enjoyed history and learning about his family's past."

Mr. Dearborn was a member and a past director of the Maine Genealogical Society.
