



"I wouldn't care if I never left Chebeague again. As far as I'm concerned, it's the last outpost of the world," he said. Chebeague "is one of the most expensive places I've ever lived because of the freight charges (on everything shipped from the mainland). But you can't have something for nothing - and I'm willing to pay the extra to be able to live here."

Mr. Doughty was a member and past vice president of Casco Bay Island Transit District, and he served on the Board of Directors.

Mr. Doughty was a selectman for the Town of Cumberland, representing Chebeague Island for two terms. He also served as president of the Chebeague Island Council for several years.

He was a member of the Chebeague Island United Methodist Church, serving as lay leader from 1985-1986. He was a member of the Chebeague Island Grange, the Kora Shrine Temple, the Odd Fellows, and the VFW and he was a 32nd degree Mason of the Scottish Rite.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing and the outdoors. He was a registered Maine Guide for 40 years.
