AUGUSTA — Leon O. Douglas, 90, of Winslow, died Monday morning at the Veterans Hospital in Togus, where he had been a patient for the past three weeks.

He was born in Augusta, Jan. 23, 1891, son of Otis E. and Elizabeth (Haskell) Douglas.

He was a longtime resident of Augusta, and graduated from Cony High School.

In World War I, he served in Intelligence and was discharged with the rank of sergeant.

Throughout his life, Mr. Douglas was actively involved with music. Following his return to Augusta after World War I, he organized a 36-piece marching band for the American Legion. Milton Herber Douglas, 77, died of an acute heart attack at his home, 23 York street, Sunday evening. He had been in failing health for the last year, and had not been so well the last two weeks. News of his death came as a shock, however, to his many friends.

Mr. Douglas has been retired since 1939, after faithfully serving at the Bath post office for 32 years.

He was born in Bath, son of J. Lufkin and Helen (Harvey) Douglas, March 30, 1874.

Mr. Douglas attended the Bath schools and was graduated from the old Bath High school in the class of 1892. Soon after he entered the employ of his father's clothing store, and following the Sagadahock block fire, he became a member of the firm of J. L. Douglas & Son. After the business was sold he entered the employ of Thompson Bros., with whom he served until entering the post office in 1907, where he made many warm friends at the delivery window. He was often heard to remark "the delivery window is a great place to study human nature." For 14 years before his retirement he was secretary of the local Civil Service Board and conducted all Civil Service examinations in the city.

In 1898 he married Miss Mary Mann, who survives him. Their marriage was blessed by two sons, Carville L., and Herbert L. Douglass, both of Bath. He also leaves one granddaughter, Betsy Jane Douglass of this city.

Mr. Douglas was a member of

the Beacon Street Methodist church, where he has served in many capacities. He was president of the Epworth League at the time of his marriage, served as superintendent of the Sunday school for more than 25 years and for over 30 years was chairman of the board of trustees and steward.

He was a past president of the Bath Branch, 520, of the United National Association of Postal Clerks; he was a member of Solar lodge of Masons; Genesta chapter, O.E.S., and Bath Camp, M. W. of A. He served two terms in the old Common Council, was a member of the School Board, 1909-1912, and was president of the Bath High School Alumni Association in 1917.

Funeral services will be Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock from the Curtis Funeral home, 942 Washington street, with Rev. Howard F. Cramer, pastor of Beacon Street Methodist church, officiating.

Hiram, Aug. 5—Alfred V. Dow, 87, prominent in town affairs here, died in his home, the historic Mt. Cutler House, today after a brief illness. He and Mrs. Dow celebrated their 66th wedding anniversary March 17.

A Republican, Dow had served several years as road commissioner, selectman and justice of the peace.
