**Gorham, July 7.**—A 64-year-old Gorham man was killed this afternoon when crushed by a tractor in a field near his home on Mighty Street.

Harold C. Dow was found pinned beneath the tractor several hours later by a neighbor, Carleton Sargent.

Dr. Frank Smith reported that Dow was killed instantly when the heavy tractor flopped over on him while Dow was haying on the side of a hill.

Medical Examiner Joseph E. Porter gave a verdict of accidental death.

Dow was born at Standish, Oct. 21, 1887, the son of Alphonse and Margaret Deering Dow.

He was a member of Hiram Lodge, AF&AM, South Portland, and a 32nd degree Mason. He was a veteran of World War I and a former member of Ralph D. Caldwell Post, AL, Portland.

## HENRY E. DOW

Henry E. Dow, 94, Nobleboro, died Tuesday at Miles Memorial Hospital.

He was born in Sheepscot, a son of Joseph and Eudora Potter Dow, and attended local schools, including Lincoln Academy in Newcastle.

After moving to New Jersey, he began his career in the automotive and truck body construction industry. He was later self-employed in that field.

Mr. Dow held patents for the hydraulic utility towers that were used in the construction of multi-story buildings, and installed them throughout the world.

He married Hannah Mae Gerstenacker in Trenton, N.J., on Aug. 5, 1926. She died last Dec. 9.

He was a 65-year member of the Alna Lodge of Mason in Damariscotta, and a member of Tall Cedars of Lebanon, Scottish Rite Bodies and Crescent Temple.

Mr. Dow was also a former member and president of the Trenton Rotary Club.



A middle-aged couple who died at their apartment at 1029 Congress St. were victims of an apparent murder-suicide, police said Sunday.
