Mr. Droggitis ran the Wonderbar with his brothers.

He was a member of St. Demetrios Church and founder and president of St. Demetrios Cemetery Association.

He was a vice president of the Maine Restaurant Association and a director of Pepperell Bank and St. Andre's Nursing Home.

He was a member of the Masons, York County Shrine Club, Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston, the Biddeford-Saco Elks Lodge, the Eagles Lodge, the AHEPA, Biddeford Senior Citizens and the Biddeford Police Association.

Surviving are three brothers, Archie of Old Orchard Beach, Ted of Los Angeles and Alexander of Biddeford, and two sisters, Zoe Elendis of Yonkers, N.Y., and Athena Gregory of Biddeford.

SCARBOROUGH - Edward Elias Dudley, 70, a bookkeeper and salesman whose struggle with Alzheimer's disease will be documented in a children's book, died Friday of complications relating to the disease at the Maine Veterans' Home here. He lived for nearly 40 years on Beech Ridge Road.

PASSAGES

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Dudley was a

bookkeeper and salesman for many years for Frank M. Brown & Sons, a paint distributor and electrical supply business at 12 Free St., Portland.

"He really did a splendid job taking care of our books," said Donald Brown, an owner. "He was the kind of person you don't find very often. He was pleasant and easy to get along with."

Mr. Dudley did bookkeeping and was on the road in sales a couple of days a week, retiring in

1985.

"It must have been difficult to have that type of disease, where he was so smart with figures."

"Alzheimer's Disease," a book written by his daughter, Susan Gold, is part of a Simon & Schuster series on diseases. It is aimed at helping fifth- and sixth-graders better understand what a grandparent might be going through.

"It has a photograph of my father with my son," said Gold, "with a quote from my son about the disease, because I wanted children to be able to relate to it. I used my father to illustrate the progress of the disease."

Mr. Dudley was first diagnosed with Alzheimer's in 1990. "We suspect he had it for a few years before that." In 1987, he went to live in North Whitefield for a few years, and was cared for by his sister, Esther M. Dudley. "In 1989, he asked if I would help him move closer to me," said his daughter. "I think he knew something was wrong, and that he would need even more help."

Mr. Dudley enjoyed the outdoors, reading and writing, although he was never published.

He married the former Helen R. Walton in 1944. They enjoyed square dancing and attended many classes and dances together before her death in 1983.

He donated his body to the University of New England for medical research. "He felt medical research was important, and he wanted to find a way to give to other people," said his daughter.

He was a radio mechanic in the Army Air Forces from 1941-45. He served in New Jersey and attained the rank of staff sergeant.
