KERMIT RUSSELL ESTEY

HOULTON — Kermit Russell Estey, 90, passed into his eter-



nal rest Feb. 28, 2005, at a local nursing home.

He was born June 15, 1914, in Sherman, the youngest child of Randolph Lawrence and Annie Elizabeth (Caldwell) Estey.

He graduated from Sherman High School and attended Bangor School of Commerce. In 1939, he married Frances M. Gardner, of East Machias, a marriage that remained strong and true for nearly 67 years. He proudly served his country as a member of the U.S. Army during World War II. Returning to the private sector Kermit became involved in the grocery business which culminated in the ownership of the Monticello IGA for nearly 20 years.
