ROCKLAND — Charles L. Grant, 82, died Sat., Sept. 22, 1990, at a Rockport hospital after a long illness. He was born at Brewer, Jan. 4, 1908, the son of Weldon and Agnes (Lewis) Grant. He was a graduate of Brewer High School, Class of 1926; Washington State Normal School at Machias in 1928; and the University of Maine at Orono in 1955. He also attended summer sessions at Oswego State Teachers College in Oswego, N.Y. He retired after teaching for 41 years in Maine schools. He was a past president of the University of Maine Alumni Association. He was a member of the Rockland Teachers Association, the Knox-Lincoln Athletic League, a past charter commander of the Knights of Pythias, a member of Aurora Lodge of Masons at Rockland and was a member of the National Education Association. He was also a member of the Maine Industrial Arts Teachers Association, a life member of the Kennebec Valley Industrial Arts Teachers Association and was a member of the Littlefield Memorial Baptist Church and had served on it's board

of trustees. His teaching career included: principal and teacher at Friendship Junior High School, Bradley Grammer School, industrial arts teacher at Norridgewock, and head of the Industrial Arts Department at Rockland District High School. He also served as a coach for the cheerleaders and softball teams at Rockland District High School. He had also taught adult education courses. Freeman Melvin Grant, 93, founder of Lions in Maine and a former member of the Maine Legislature and Portland City Council, died yesterday in Atlanta, Ga.

Mr. Grant was a member of the legislature from 1905 to 1909 and a state senator in 1917 and 1919. He served a term on the Portland City Council in the early 1920's and was a candidate for mayor.

He was born in Freeport July 18, 1868, the son of Charles S. and Sarah Bragdon Grant. He attended Freeport schools and in 1896 married Carrie L. Lewis. Some months ago Mr. Grant was hospitalized as the result of a fall, but had returned to his home some months ago. He was born in the Deering section of Portland when it was part of Westbrook.

He received his early schooling in Westbrook and Cambridgeport, Mass., later attending Harvard Law School. He then went to Texas with Harvard friends intending to go into New Mexico. While en route to the latter territory members of the party were attacked by Apache Indians, some of the men being massacred. For some time Grant was thought to have been among the victims and his obituary was published in a paper in Meriden, Conn., where his parents resided.

Returning to Texas, Grant practiced law after being admitted to the bar in 1879. Soon afterwards he came back to New England and was a traveling salesman. He later became affiliated with the former Portland plumbing firm of A. L. Dow & Company, retiring from the business in 1920. His firm equipped one or more buildings at Bowdoin College and barracks and officers' quarters at Fort McKinley, Portland Harbor.

A 32nd degree Mason, Mr. Grant was a past master of Deering Lodge, AF&AM; past high priest of Mount Vernon Chapter, past illustrious master of Portland Council and a member of Portland Commandery, Knights Templar. He was also an honorary member of Meriden Lodge of Elks, and he and Mrs. Grant were formerly members of Deering Chapter, OES.

Surviving besides his widow, Mrs. Harriet F. Grant, is a grandson, Philip Barnhard, of Mt. Carmel, Ill. A daughter, Mrs. Mabel Barnhard, died about 12 years ago.

George F. Grant, 89, resident of Portland much of his life, and at one time active in local Masonry, died Thursday in the home of Laura B. Beach, 1229 Forest Avenue, where he and his wife had resided in recent months. They had lived for many years at 1212 Forest Avenue.

FALMOUTH — Dr. Henry H. Grant, 81, a longtime Portland dentist and dental surgeon, died Saturday in Madison, Conn.

Dr. Grant practiced for 46 years in Portland, and was a partner for many years in a Congress Street practice begun in 1902 by his father, Dr. Giles C. Grant. They had an office for many years in the Trelawney Building at 655 Congress St. Before that, their office was next door to the former George C. Shaw's Grocery Store near Congress Square.

Dr. Grant was also chief of dental surgery for 19 years at Maine Medical Center. He retired from dentistry altogether in the mid-1980s.

He and his wife, Gladys I. Hughes Grant, lived many years at 10 Sunset Ave. here.

Before that, they lived in Portland in a house at 16 Bramhall St. The house was torn down in the early 1970s as part of an expansion of the Maine Medical Center. It was an ornate old house, consistent with its West End neighborhood, according to Dr. Grant's son-in-law, Jack Evans.

"It included all the things builders have forgotten how to make now, and that designers no longer include in

the plans," Evans said. Its most interesting feature, Evans said, was a below-ground tunnel leading directly into the hospital, which Dr. Grant used often during the period that he was chief of dental surgery.

Dr. Grant enjoyed woodturning and made bowls and numerous other items, often experimenting with the wood from a neighbor's apple tree or cherry tree, just to see what he could create by turning wood of various grains and colors.

Born in Portland, a son of Giles and Gertrude Murphy Grant, he graduated from Portland High School, the University of Maine and in 1934 from Harvard Dental School.

He served 39 months in the Army during World War II as a major in the 67th General Hospital Unit, and also was a lieutenant colonel in the Army Dental Corps Reserves.

Dr. Grant was a former president of both the Portland Dental Society and the Maine Dental Society. He was a member of the New England Dental Society, the International College of Dentists, the Masons and the First Parish Church, Portland.

Dr. and Mrs. Grant were married Aug. 17, 1935, in Windham. She died Aug. 11, 1990.

Surviving are a son, Henry H. Jr. of New York City and East Hampton, Long Island, N.Y.; a daughter, Mrs. Jack (Judith) Evans of Guilford, Conn.; a sister, Elizabeth Adams of Westborough, Mass.; and four grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday in Chapel A of the Jones, Rich & Hutchins Funeral Home, Portland. The Rev. Frederick Lipp will officiate. Burial will follow in Brooklawn Memorial Park, Portland.
