The lightship is now a floating museum in Lewes, Del., which he visited last spring.

"He enjoyed going over the old ship," said his daughter. "They asked him to give a recorded message for the museum about what life was like aboard the ship."

Born in New Harbor, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Hanna, he spent a year in bed with polio as a child. He graduated from Bristol High School and worked as a fisherman and later a rigger at Bath Iron Works during World War II.

Mr. Hanna was a member of the Bristol Lodge of Masons and enjoyed boating, travel, storytelling and playing billiards.

His first wife, Catherine Benner Hanna, died in 1973, and his second wife, Faye Ungerson Hanna, also died previously.

Surviving are his wife, Jean Stone Hanna; his son and daughter, all of New Harbor; two stepsons, Andrew Ungerson of Billerica, Mass., and Jaffrey Veeder of Syracuse, N.Y.; two stepdaughters, Mary Adlin of Windham and Sarah Brown of Baton Rouge, La.; a brother, Loring of New Harbor; and eight grandchildren.
