SHAPLEIGH – Lloyd E. Hooper, 85, of Back Road, died Saturday at home after a long illness.

He was born in Shapleigh, a son of Fred and Mabel Hooper. He attended the former Ross School, the former Lindsey High School, and was a lifelong Shapleigh resident.

In years past, he had served the town of Shapleigh as a road commissioner and as a selectman.

He served as postmaster of the Shapleigh Post Office from 1940 until his retirement in 1982. He also formerly served as a deputy for the York County Sheriff's Department and had charge of the first jury seated in the Alfred court when it was new.

He was a member of the Shapleigh Corner Baptist Church, and was an honorary life deacon.

He was a member and past master of the Mousam Lake Grange, was a member of the Day Spring Lodge, OES, in West Newfield, was an honorary member of the Shapleigh Fire Department, and was a 60-plus year member of the Springvale Lodge #190 AF & AM.

Surviving are his wife of 59 years, Mildred Laskey Hooper of Shapleigh; and a daughter, Mrs. Robert (Jane) Hilton of Berwick.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. at the Heald Funeral Home, 61 Main St., Springvale, with the Rev. Dr. Nelson Elliot, pastor of the Shapleigh Corner Baptist Church, officiating. Burial will be in the spring in Pine Grove Cemetery, South Waterboro.

Hooper was born Nov. 13, 1889, at Biddeford, son of the late Leonard R. and Etta M. McNeally Hooper. He attended Biddeford and Saco schools and Gray's Business College, Portland. After leaving school he worked for the American Express Company here and in Bangor.

He was appointed a U. S. bailiff here in 1912 and during the next two years served as a part-time stenographer to the late Judge William L. Putnam of the U. S. Circuit Court of Appeals. He was named court reporter for the U. S. District Court of Maine in 1912, and had served under Federal Judges Clarence Hale, John A. Peters and John D. Clifford, jr. During World War I he served in the army as a private.

Hooper was a member of the Masons and the American Legion.

Besides his wife he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Bettina M. Morgan and Mrs. William G. Bell, and one grandson, all of South Portland.

Clyde O. Hooper, Jr. 1921-2007 LONGMEADOW - Clyde O. Hooper Jr., 85, of Longmeadow passed away on Sunday, February 11, 2007. He was born in Lewiston, Maine on June 9, 1921, the beloved son of the late Clyde O. Hooper Sr. and Myrtle (Ellis) Hooper. He was a member of Springfield Commandery #6, Knights Templar, Emminent Commander 1981-82, the Scottish Rite Bodies - Valley of Springfield, York Rite Bodies Hiram Royal Arch Chapter #70 in South Portland, ME., High Priest 1956-57; Portland Council #4, Royal and Select Masters. He became a Shriner in 1971, joining Melha Temple. Clyde was appointed Captain of the Guard by Jack Butterfield and became Potentate of Melha Temple in 1989. He is a Member and Past President Directors Staff, Member Legion of Honor, Past Masters, Honorary Member Clown Unit, Member Old Timers, Hill Billies and five Shrine Clubs; St. Matthew's Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine, Puissant Sovereign 1989 and Royal Order of Jesters, Court #144. He is a Charter Member Order of Quetzalcoatl. He served as Assistant Circus Chairman from 1991 to 2005 and was an Associate Member of the Board of Governors of the Shriners Hospital in Springfield. He leaves his wife of 8 years, Vivian (Nelson) Higgins Hooper of Cape Cod, MA. He is predeceased by his wife of 41 years, Gloria (Allen) Hooper. He leaves his son Gary R. Hooper and wife, Paula, of Longmeadow. His six beloved grandchildren, Scott Hooper of Sagamore Beach, MA, Stephen Hooper of Clearwater, FL, Jason Hooper of Hamden, CT, Kelly Gilman of Foxborough, MA, Alisa Adams of Carlisle, PA, and Andrea Adams of Cincinnati, OH. 
