CAMDEN - Lawrence N. Hopkins, 86, of 66 Washington Street, died unexpectedly at his home on Wednesday, July 26, 2000. Born in Bangor, Aug. 26, 1913, he was the son of Nathan and Lucia (Shute) Hopkins.

In 1932, he graduated from Camden High School and went to work at the Camden Farmers Union until being drafted in 1942. Hopkins served four years in the U.S. Army in the Pacific theater attaining the rank of first sergeant and was discharged in January of 1946. On June 13, 1943, he married Adele C. Hawkins of Tenants Harbor at the Tenants Harbor Baptist Church. In March of 1946, Hopkins went to work at Camden National Bank where he served in various positions for 32 1/2 years. In 1951 he was promoted to assistant cashier, in 1964 promoted to executive vice president and served on the board

of directors. In 1965 he was elected president, serving 13 years in that position, retiring in 1978. He continued to serve on the board of directors for ten years. Mr. Hopkins has been very active in civic, fraternal, and banking organizations over the years, having served as president and director of the Camden Rotary Club, Camden-Rockport Chamber of Commerce, Camden Y.M.C.A., and the K.S.K.L. Chapter of the American Institute of Banking. He also served as director of the Camden Community Hospital, Maine Bankers Association and held membership in the Keystone Chapter and the Claremont Commandery; past master of the Megunticook Grange and the Amity Lodge of Masons No. 6; trustee of the Anita Card Montgomery Foundation; director of Douglas Thom Memorial Corporation, Megunticook Watershed Association; member of State and National Grange. A long

time member of the Chestnut Street Baptist Church, Mr. Hopkins had previously served as president and trustee.

Surviving are his wife, Adele C. Hopkins of Camden; one son, Allan L. Hopkins and his wife, Alice of Camden; three grandchildren. Visiting hours will be 6-8 p.m. Friday, July 28, 2000 at Laite & Pratt Funeral Home, 9 Mountain Street, Camden. The funeral will be 2 p.m. Saturday, July 29, 2000, at Chestnut Street Baptist Church with the Rev. Wayne Wallace officiating. Burial will be in Mountain View Cemetery. A reception will be held in the church fellowship hall after the burial. The family suggests memorial donations be made to Chestnut Street Baptist Church, P.O. Box 833, Camden, Maine 04843.
