George W. Hovey, 67, of 53 Back Cove Estates, died Sunday in a Portland hospital.





With the late Dr. Arthur Gould, he was co-founder of the town's first and only hospital, a 10-bed institution which they ran from 1926 to 1941. Dr. How- ard then ran the hospital him- self for five more years. Dr. Howard was also the area's medical examiner for many years. |

He was born in Woodstock. N.B., Feb. 2, 1871, the son of the Rev. George and Mary Eliza Clark Howard, He received his education through college in Centerville, N.B. He was graduated from the Rush Memorial Medical School of Chicago University in 1894.

He came to Freeport to practice 59 years ago and has been here ever since except for 15 years he spent in the Middle. West. He returned, he said, because he "missed the tides." While in Oklahoma City, he served on the examining board for World War I. From there he moved to Albion, Neb, where he was medical examiner for 10 years.

Dr. Howard liked to recall the

horse and buggy days of medicine. He loved horses and brought his first one with him from Centerville by boxcar. He always felt grateful to the kindly tramp who fed and watered the animal during the trip.

After the horse and buggy went out, Dr. Howard became an advocate of the Model T Ford, owning 14 of them before they, too, went out of style. Dr. Howard was twice honored in recent years. In 1952. he was presented a 50 - year medal by the Freeport Masonic Lodge of which he was a member. And last June, he was awarded a 60-year service pin by the Cumberland County Medical Society.

He was a member of the Freeport Chamber of Commerce and active in civic affairs.
