### George F. Hoyt

George Fickett Hoyt, 68, of 31 Hoyt Street, nearly 40 years connected with the postal service in South Portland, 22 years as superintendent of the office in that city, died Wednesday in the Maine Eye & Ear Infirmary.

Born at South Portland Jan. 8, 1873, Mr. Hoyt was a resident there all his life. He entered the postal service July 26, 1902, as a substitute clerk, becoming a regular clerk the following Nov. 8. He was promoted to superintendent July 1, 1918, and was retired Jan. 31, last.

East Hiram, Sept. 25.—The Rev.

Hervey H. Hoyt passed away Monday at his home here. He was born Sept. 5, 1868 in Manchester, Wis., the son of the late Edwin L. and Amanda Foster Hoyt.

He moved with his family to Peabody, Kan., at an early age, where he received his early education and taught for a short period of time. He came East and attended Westbrook Seminary in Portland, graduating in 1890.

In 1894, the Rev. Hoyt graduated from Tufts College, where he took the Divinity course. In 1893 he married Minnie A. Rankin of Hiram. His first parish was at Methuen, Mass. He later held pastorates at St. Johnsbury, Vermont and Portland, Oregon.

The Rev. Hoyt moved to Hiram, where he held a pastorate for several years, also serving the surrounding communities. His next two pastorates were at Hoopeston, Ill., and Waltham, Mass. He then returned to Hiram, where for the past 20 years he has served Hiram and North Fryeburg.

He was State Superintendent of the Universalist Churches for a time, and is a past president of Westbrook Seminary. In 1944 he was awarded a gold medal from Tufts College honoring his 50th year in the ministry. He is a member of the K of P, Hiram; Mt. Cutler Grange, Hiram, and is a 32nd degree Mason.

Besides his wife, he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Vera Bacon, East Hiram; a twin sister, Mrs. Helen Prescott, Peabody, Kan.; two grandchildren, Elizabeth Pitman, East Hiram, and Helen Black of West Baldwin, and one great grandson, Harold L. Pitman of East Hiram.

Funeral services were held Thursday at the Universalist Church, Hiram, with interment in the Village Cemetery, East Hiram.

Presque Isle, March 6—Thomas Merle Hoyt, 64, prominent Presque Isle farmer and potato buyer, died at his home on the Houlton Road Saturday night, after an illness of many months.

Mr. Hoyt was born at Easton, Oct. 26, 1873, the son of John F. and Julia Weymouth Hoyt and was first associated in business with Thomas Fisher of Fort Fairfield. Later he was affiliated with Carter and Corey of Easton, Meiborne Smith of Presque Isle, Cliff F. Wheeler of Presque Isle and Earl Kneeland of Easton. Justice Hudson, first Piscataquis County attorney to be named to a state court, was appointed justice of the Superior Court in 1929 by Gov. William Tudor Gardiner.

He was born March 21, 1878, the son of Henry, jr., and Ada Lougee Hudson. He was graduated from Coburn Classical Institute in 1896 and prepared for law school at Colby College, where he received his degree in 1900.

Receiving an honorary LLD degree from Colby in 1932, he was named to the Board of Trustees of the college a year later. He was appointed a trustee of the Guilford Trust Company the same year.

For many years he was a member of the Republican State Committee and a member of the State Board of Bar Examiners. He was instrumental in organizing the Piscataquis Valley Country Club and was its first president.

He married Mary Stevens McKown of Boothbay Harbor Nov. 11, 1903.

He was a Mason, a member of the Knights of Pythias and Knights Templar and the Guilford Chamber of Commerce. He belonged to the Delta Kappa Epsilon, social, and Phi Beta Kappa, honorary, fraternities while in college.

Surviving besides his widow are a daughter, Mrs. John Power White, and three grandchildren: Mary Loantha, James Henry Hudson and Betsey Louise White all of Guilford.
