J. E. Hughes Dies At Bath

BATH, June 25. (Special)—J. Edward Hughes, 71, assistant cashier of the Bath Trust Company since 1906, and brother of the late Admiral Charles F. Hughes, onetime Chief of Naval Operations of the U. S. Navy, was found dead in bed at his home this morning.

Monson, Nov. 20 — William R. Hughes, Sr., Monson's oldest male citizen and grand old man passed away at the home of his daughter Mrs. Leonard A. Stanchfield Sunday forenoon Nov. 14, age 88 years 11 months and 10 days.

Mr. Hughes was born in Wales, Dec. 4, 1848, started school at age of 7 and finished his schooling at age 11. When he was 12 years old he worked in a copper mine and at age 13 he commenced work in the slate mines in Wales where he worked until 17½ years old. At age 18 or in 1866 he came to the United States and located in Vermont where he worked in the slate quarries until 1875 when he came to Monson where he has since

made his home and followed the slate business up to within the past two years.

In March 1885 he joined Onaway Lodge, I. O. O. F. and was elected Noble Grand in 1889. He served the district as D. D. G. M. in 1900-1901 and again in 1910-1911. Mr. Hughes was honored many times by Onaway Lodge, perhaps the greatest when they presented him with a Past Grand's Jewel and Regalia. He was historian of Onaway Lodge at the 50th anniversary on Feb. 21, 1934.

He was also a member of Eldorado Encampment, Dover-Foxcroft, and was one of the few remaining charter members of North Star Rebekah lodge.

In 1886 he became a member of Doric Lodge F. and A. M. and served as Master in 1908-1909 and was appointed D. D. G. M. in 1911-1912. He was a great lover of Masonry. He was a valued member of Euclid Chapter, O. E. S., the Chapter and Council in Dover-Foxcroft.

He was twice married, by his first wife five children were born, four of whom are now living, namely Mrs. Leonard A. Stanchfield, John P. and Howell all of this town and William R. Jr. of Derby. Mrs. Hughes passed away nearly 20 years ago. Some years later he was married to Mrs. Anna Gilbert who survives him.

Funeral services were held from the Congregational church Wednesday afternoon, Nov. 17. Doric Lodge

performed the Maconic funeral service and interment was in the New Cemetery.
