LYMAN — Lawrence F. Hutchins Sr., 74, of South Waterboro Road, died at home Tuesday after a long illness.

He was born Aug. 25, 1920, in Portsmouth, N.H., a son of Melvin E. and Madge L. Walsh Hutchins, and graduated from Portsmouth High School.

During World War II Mr. Hutchins served in the Army in the Arno, southern France, Rhineland and central European campaigns. Returning home, he was employed as a submarine electrician at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard until retiring in 1960.

During the 1960s he worked at Eastern Plastics in Sanford and its affiliate in Framingham, Mass. From the 1970s until 1990 he was employed as a security guard at Black Bear, Hall and M.B.I. security.

Mr. Hutchins lived in Lyman since 1964 and was a member of the Goodwins Mills Methodist Church.

He was a 32nd-degree Mason with the River Mouth Masonic Lodge in Portsmouth. He and his first wife, Eleanor Pooler Hutchins, were active in the Order of the Eastern Star and had been past worthy grand matron and patron. She died in 1980.

He was an avid hunter, fisherman and outdoorsman. He also enjoyed model trains and maintained large collections of N, HO and O gauge trains.
