LAKE WALES, Fla. — Dr. Ralph H. Hutchinson, 89, for many years an oral surgeon in Portland, Maine, died Friday. He had lived here the past 20 years.

He was born in Augusta, Maine, the son of Charles and Bella Hutchinson, and attended Augusta schools. A graduate of Cony High School, Augusta, and the University of Pennsylvania School of Dentistry, he practiced dentistry in Westbrook, Maine, and, after studying at Winter's School of Exodontia, established a practice of oral surgery in Portland, retiring in 1959. For many years he was chief of dental service at Maine Medical Center.

Dr. Hutchinson was a member of the Greater Portland Dental Society, Maine Dental Association, American Dental Association, Cumberland Club and Portland Skeet Club. He was a past master of the Masons and past president of the Maine Fish and Game Association and was one of the early members of the Westbrook Kiwanis Club.

He is survived by two sons, Lewis Hutchinson of Cumberland, Maine, and Dr. Robert B. Hutchinson of Cape Elizabeth, Maine; a brother, Carl D. Hutchinson of Augusta, Maine; and seven grandchildren.

His first wife, the former Louise Lewis, died in 1950. His late wife, the former Louise Libby, died several years ago.

BATH — Guy B. Hynes, 71, a retired mail carrier who collected kerosene lamps, died Thursday at Mid Coast Hospital in Brunswick after a short illness.

Mr. Hynes retired in 1987 after 42 years as a mail carrier in the Bath area.

He was a member of the class of 1942 at Morse High School, but was called into the Army Air Corps a few months before graduating.

"They cleaned out the whole senior class that year, right after Christmas," said his sister, Ruth H. Kistler. "It was at the peak of the war. That was a sad day."

After less than a year in the service he was discharged, and he completed his high school education in 1943.

Mr. Hynes had a keen interest in antiques, particularly kerosene

lamps, old postcards of the Bath area, and clocks.

"He especially loved lamps," said his sister. He enjoyed restoring them."

Mr. Hynes found his lamps at auctions and flea markets.

He went for the old-fashioned colored lamps and the Aladdin-style lamps, said his sister. "He found it harder to find them in recent years. We used to go to auctions, but everything's become so expensive, we stopped going to the auctions."

For several years Mr. Hynes had a workshop at his home that he called "The Lamp Shack" where he restored and repaired lamps, sold parts and did contract work for antique dealers.

Born in Arlington, Mass., a son of William I. and Ruth Beddeos Hynes, he came to Bath in 1933. He was a member of Solar Lodge of Masons and Dunlap Commandery.

Mr. Hynes was formerly married to Dorothy Wing Hynes.
