Erwin George Klauber, 60, resident of Portland many years, died about midnight Saturday night in the Veterans' Facility Hospital at Togus after illness of a month.

Born in Vienna, Austria, Mr. Klauber came to the United States with his parents when he was 14 years old. As a young man he enlisted in 155th Company, Coast Artillery, at Fort Slocum, N. 
