Edward F. Knight, 74, of the Johnson Road, Falmouth Foreside, more than half a century engaged in business in this City and Falmouth, died Sunday afternoon in a Portland hospital, where eight days ago he underwent a surgical operation.

Prominently identified with Falmouth, town and other activities Mr. Knight served as health officer many years, chief of the Falmouth Foreside fire company, of which he was one of the organizers, and was a member of the Pine Grove Cemetery Board.

Born in Falmouth, Dec. 16, 1867, he conducted a plumbing business on Munjoy Hill in this City as a young man, and since in his native town.

He was a member of Casco Lodge, AF and AM, of Yarmouth, which he served in many offices, last year as chairman of the board of trustees; Portland Council, RAM; Tolam Tribe of Red Men, of which he was a past sagem, and of the Foreside Methodist Church.

Funeral services for George L. Knight, formerly of 89 Pine Street, who died Friday evening after an illness of 11 years, will be at 2.30 p. m., Monday, at 749 Congress Street and interment in Evergreen Cemetery.

Mr. Knight was born in the old Knight homestead at Cape Elizabeth 74 years ago, son of Elinor Maxwell Knight and the late Charles A. S. Knight.

He resided in Portland nearly all his life and was employed by the First National Bank 48 years, retiring as assistant cashier 11 years ago because of ill health.
