Westbrook, Nov. 16.—George H. Knowlton, 78, of 59 Mechanic Street, treasurer of the Knowlton Machine Company and a former city official, died Monday night in his home after an illness of several months.

He was born at Westbrook Dec. 8, 1869, son of John and Susan Dennison Knowlton. He attended Westbrook schools and was graduated from Gray's Business College in Portland. He was employed as an accountant in a local grist mill for several years and 50 years ago, with his father and brother, founded the Knowlton Machine Company with which he had since been associated. He had served 12 years as city auditor.

He was a past master of Temple Lodge, F and AM; a past high priest of Eagle Chapter, RAM; a past illustrious master of Westbrook Council, RSM, and a member of St. Alban Commandery, Knights Templar. He had been affiliated with these Masonic bodies more than 50 years and also held the 32nd degree in the Scottish Rite Masons and was a member of the Red Cross of Constantine. He had been president of the Westbrook Masonic Corporation since its organization more than 25 years ago. Mr. Knowlton was a charter member of the Woodfords Club of Portland and attended the Westbrook Congregational Church.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Sarah L. Knowlton; two sons, Ralph W. and George H. Knowlton, jr., Westbrook; five daughters, Mrs. S. Esther Mitchell and Mrs. Effie L. Hay, Westbrook, Mrs. F. Westbrook, Jan. 15—John Dennison Knowlton, 80, of Reading, Mass., former president of the Knowlton Machine Company here, died this afternoon in a St. Petersburg, Fla., hospital of heart disease. He had been in poor health several months.

Mr. Knowlton was born here, son of the late John and Susan Dennison Knowlton, and was educated in the Westbrook schools, the old Gorham Academy and Westbrook Seminary. He became associated with his brother, George H. Knowlton in the former John J. Knowlton Machine Company, founded by their father. When the concern was incorporated as the Knowlton Machine Company in 1912, he became its president.

He moved to Malden, Mass., at the time of the First World War and, about 20 years ago, to Reading, where he became associated with the Sanford Mills.

His first wife was Effie Clark Knowlton who died in 1918.

Also surviving are his second wife, Mrs. Elizabeth Whitney Knowlton, a daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Cunningham of Los Angeles, Calif., and several nieces and nephews.

Alleged Spy Tells How Job Protected

Ellsworth, Aug. 4.—John F. Knowlton, 92, former clerk of U. S. District Court in Maine and retired Ellsworth lawyer and former court officer here, died tonight at his home on Main Street.

Mr. Knowlton, one of this city's oldest residents, had a shock earlier in the week.

He was born at South Montville March 19, 1856, the son of John Colby Knowlton, and educated in public schools there, at Eastern Maine Conference Seminary, Bucksport, and Waite's Business College, Augusta.

He taught school at Searsmont, Montville, Liberty and Hope, and in 1876 became a teacher at Bucksport Seminary, resigned to enter business and returned there as head of the commercial department.

In 1890, he was appointed clerk of the Maine Supreme Court for Hancock County and moved to Ellsworth. He served in that position for 20 years, and was municipal court judge while that office was from time to time vacant.

In 1910, he became a law partner of retired Federal Judge John F. Peters here. He retired from his practice for a year in 1915 due to ill health, but returned in 1916. In 1917, he was confidential secretary for Judge Peters, who had become Federal judge, and was later appointed clerk of the U. S. District Court for Maine.

He returned to Ellsworth in 1936 and retired in 1938. In all, off and on, he had lived 40 years here.

Mr. Knowlton was a Republican, a Knight Templar and an Odd Fellow.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. William E. Whiting, Ellsworth, and Mrs. K. M. Cameron, Ottawa, Ont., and a son, Dr. Charles C. Knowlton, Ellsworth.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Saturday from his Main Street home. The Rev. Malcom MacDuffie will officiate. Burial will be in Woodbine Cemetery.
