



Funeral services for William T. Libby, 68, sportsman, first postmaster at Oxbow and prominent in the town's government, who died Monday at one of his camps at Milinockett Lake, were held Wednesday at his home at Oxbow. Mr. Libby, who owned 50 camps on Aroostook and Allegash waters, was on a tour of inspection of his properties at the time of his death. He had been in failing health three years.

The son of the late Charles and Melissa Trafton Libby, Mr. Libby was born at Oxbow where he spent his entire life. He had served the town as selectman, tax collector and as a member of the school committee, and never failed to have a prominent part in the annual town meeting. He was a member of Pioneer Lodge of Masons, the Order of Eastern Star and the Aroostook Valley Fish and Game Club.
