CAPE ELIZABETH — Clinton H. Murray, 91, co-founder, former president and chairman of F.P. & C.H. Murray Contractors, died Thursday at a Scarborough veterans' home after a long illness.

Mr. Murray and his father formed F.P. & C.H. Murray Contractors in Cape Elizabeth in 1933 and served as president for 47 years until 1972. He was chairman until his retirement in 1988.

The company is a well-known builder and restorer. It restored the Longfellow House and the H.H. Hay

building, moved the so-called Gothic House to upper Spring Street, and rehabilitated the Dow Mansion and the Mariner's Church.

Mr. Murray's grandfather, William D. Murray, began the family's building tradition in 1858.

Mr. Murray's grandfather and father, Fred P., built the Cape Elizabeth Town Hall at the turn of the century, and Mr. Murray remembered pounding nails as a boy of 12 during the construction of the Pond

Cove Annex School. "Back then, all you used were hand tools, and it took a year to build a house," he recalled in a 1987 Press Herald story.

Mr. Murray was a charter member of Cape Elizabeth Hose Company 6, and served as the town's fire chief from 1953-1957. He was active in fighting the 1947 forest fires that hit the Hollis, Bar Mills and Goodwins Mills area, according to his sister, Constance Murray.

An avid yachtsman, Mr. Murray for many years skippered the Connie M., a 28-foot vessel built by his father during the Depression.

Born in Cape Elizabeth, a son of Fred and Blanche Heywood Murray, he attended Cape Elizabeth schools and graduated from Hebron Academy. He served in the Army in World War I.

He was a life member of the New England Fire Chief's Association, a member of the Maine Fire Chief's Association, a 25-year member of Hiram Lodge of Masons, a member of Kora Shrine, the Cape Elizabeth Grange and the Cape Elizabeth Historic Preservation Society. He served on the town's Charter Committee and the Riverside Cemetery Association.

He lived at 381 Spurwink Ave. His wife, Grace M. Murray, died in 1975.

Surviving are two sons, Elmer of Cape Elizabeth and K. Wayne of Denmark; a sister, Constance Murray of South Portland; seven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

GREENVILLE - William L. 'Bill' Muzzy of Indian Hill, Greenville, passed away on Dec. 2, 2003 after a long and complicated illness.

He was born on April 3, 1934 in Greenville, a son of Edmund D. Muzzy and mother, Elaine (Bartley) Muzzy. In 1952, Bill graduated from Greenville High School and entered the University of Maine with a concentration in farm management.

After completing his studies, he returned to Greenville to marry Carolyn Rowe and to work with his father at Indian Hill Farm.

Following the premature death of his father in 1959, Bill became owner/manager of Indian Hill Farm, which included a companion holstein farm in Guilford and a dairy in Greenville.

In the early 1960s, Bill, with the partnership and support of both his wife, Callie, and his mother, Elaine, expanded Indian Hill Farm to include a modern milking barn and the Moosehead area's first motel, Indian Hill Motel.

A noon lunch in June 1972 brought a family vote to sell the cows and close the dairy. Using the remaining farm equipment Bill entered the earthwork contracting business under the title of 'Indian Hill Construction.'

In 1978, Bill and Callie founded a small grocery and sporting goods store known as 'Indian Hill Trading Post.' Not able to resist the freedom of the outdoors and his interest in construction, Bill returned to earthwork contracting in 1982 with his son Mark. Bill remained in active charge of Indian Hill Construction until 1997, when his health began to slowly fail.

For many years, Bill lead an active service life in Greenville, including Cub Scout Troop Master, Member of Board of Selectmen and Chamber of Commerce, Board Member and Board Chairman for School Administrative District No. 2, Member of Greenville Fire Department, and Member of Columbia-Doric Masonic Lodge.
