GREENVILLE - William L. 'Bill' Muzzy of Indian Hill, Greenville, passed away on Dec. 2, 2003 after a long and complicated illness.

He was born on April 3, 1934 in Greenville, a son of Edmund D. Muzzy and mother, Elaine (Bartley) Muzzy. In 1952, Bill graduated from Greenville High School and entered the University of Maine with a concentration in farm management.

After completing his studies, he returned to Greenville to marry Carolyn Rowe and to work with his father at Indian Hill Farm.

Following the premature death of his father in 1959, Bill became owner/manager of Indian Hill Farm, which included a companion holstein farm in Guilford and a dairy in Greenville.

In the early 1950s, Bill, with the partnership and support of both his wife, Callle, and his mother, Elaine, expanded Indian Hill Farm to include a modern milking barn and the Moosehead area's first motel, Indian Hill Motel.

A noon lunch in June 1972 brought a family vote to sell the cows and close the dairy. Using the remaining farm equipment Bill entered the earthwork contracting business under the title of 'Indian Hill Construction.'

In 1978, Bill and Callie founded a small grocery and sporting goods store known as 'Indian Hill Trading Post.' Not able to resist the freedom of the outdoors and his interest in construction, Bill returned to earthwork contracting in 1982 with his son Mark. Bill remained in active charge of Indian Hill Construction until 1997, when his health beant to slowly fail.

For many years, Bill lead an active service life in Greenville, including Cub Scout Troop Master, Member of Board of Selectmen and Chamber of Commerce, Board Member and Board Chairman for School Administrative District No. 2, Member of Greenville Fire Department, and Member of Columbia-Doric Masonic Lodge.

Bill also took great enjoyment from hunting and fishing in the areas between Wilson Pond and Ragged Lake, as well as following the school athletic teams. In spite of his out-of-
