Scarborough, July 8.—Funeral services will be held at 1 p. m. Saturday at 11 Mellen Street, Portland, for Sidney P. Nash, 78, veteran Maine telegrapher and Masonic official, who died while vacationing with Mrs. Nash at Grand Beach here today.

Mr. Nash was born at Rockland Dec. 23, 1871, and as a young man was employed as telegrapher in Taunton, Mass., Nobleboro and Rockland before coming to Portland in 1901 to work as an Associated Press operator. For the past 20 years he was employed as telegrapher in the Portland office of Hornblower & Weeks.

BRUNSWICK — Uriah N. Nash, 90, prominent Brunswick businessman, died yesterday after an illness of two years.

Mr. Nash was for more than 45 years proprietor of the J. E. Davis Company. The business, originally established in 1900 by his father-in-law, Joseph E. Davis, was operated by Mr. Nash while he was still devoting much of his time on the road as a sales representative of leading clothing firms.

He took over full-time operation when the elderly Mr. Davis retired. Mr. Nash himself retired in 1961, when the business was sold to Philmore Ross of Brunswick.

An ardent sportsman, Mr. Nash was one of the early supporters of the Brunswick Golf Club. He likewise was active in conservation work centering around Merrymeeting Bay.

He attended the First Parish

Church, and was a trustee of Brunswick Savings Institution, an honorary member of Brunswick Rotary Club, belonged to United Lodge, F. and A. M., and Royal Arch Chapter.

A native of Harrington, he was born April 15, 1873, to Frederick L. and Sarah Wass Nash. He resided in Portland several years before moving to

POLAND SPRING — W. Ballard Nash Sr., 75, of West Crestwood Drive died Thursday at Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston after a long illness.

He was born in Worcester, Mass., a son of Edward F. and Jennie Churchill Nash, attended Worcester schools and graduated from South High School.

Mr. Nash joined the Navy in 1943 and worked as an aviation electronic technician's mate. He was awarded the World War II Victory Medal, the American area Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

After the war he moved to Maine, and worked as an electronic technician for Snow's Inc. of Auburn. In 1962, he started his own business, Bal's TV. In the 1970s, he was employed by Eastern Security Systems, retiring in 1988 because of ill health.

He joined Tyrian Masonic Lodge in 1964 and was named master in 1970. In 1993, he was honored as Mason of the Year. He also assembled a monthly newsletter for all organizations that met at the Masonic temple.

Mr. Nash was an original member of the Poland Fire Department in 1967. He was chief of both the fire and rescue departments from 1975 until 1977. He later became Poland's first emergency medical technician and taught many EMT and crash injury courses. He also taught first aid for the Maine Safety Council.

He was a member of the American Legion Post in Mechanic Falls, where he was recipient of the Citizen of the Year award in 1994. He was a former member of the Poland School Committee, the Poland Planning Board, the Poland Community Club and was a life member of the Poland Historical Society. He also was correspondent for and on the board of directors of the Poland News Flash.

In 1990, he was awarded the Sabbathday Lake Grange Community Service Award and in 1995, the Melvin Jones Fellowship Award from the Lions Club.

Surviving are his wife Patricia Adams Nash of Poland Spring; a daughter, Mrs. Gary (Karen) Renard of Auburn; two sons, W. Ballard of Poland and Michael of Westbrook; a brother, Edward F. of Norway; and a granddaughter and a grandson.

Visiting hours will be 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m. today at Weston-Chandler Funeral Home, 26 West Dwinal St., Mechanic Falls, where Masonic services will be conducted at 7:30 p.m.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at Poland Community Church.

Civil War Veteran, 90, Buried At Gray; Patriotic Organi- zations Represented

GRAY, Sept. 17. (Special)—Members of patriotic organizations joined with his neighbors in paying final tribute to Col. Charles E. Nason, Gray resident of many years and one of the best known Civil War veterans in Maine, at funeral services this afternoon in the Congregational Church here. Col. Nason died early Wednesday at his home here, four days after returning from the annual National encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic, which he and a few other Maine veterans attended at Madison, Wis.

The Rev. Arthur Wallace, pastor of the Congregational Church, officiated at the funeral services at 2 o'clock using the Episcopal burial ritual, which was followed by Presumptscot Lodge of Masons conducting its ritual both in the church and at the grave in Gray Cemetery.

Also attending the services in the church were delegations of members of George F. Shepley Relief Corps of Gray, of which Col. Nason was for many years an honorary member; Bosworth Post, G. A. R., of Portland; Shepley Camp, Sons of Union Veterans, of Portland, and Gray Post, American Legion.

Gray Post provided a firing squad, which fired a salute over the grave, and the post buglar sounded taps.
