He was also president of the board of trustees for St. Demetrios Greek Orthodox Church and was the chairman of the remodeling committee that converted the Adams Street church structure into a modern religious facility.

Surviving are his wife, Margaret Bogatses Scontras; three sons, Peter, Theodore and Charles, all of Saco; two brothers, Harry P. of Dover, N.H., and Andrew P. of Biddeford Pool; his sister, Freda Zotos of Cohasset, Mass.; and five grandchildren.
