LITCHFIELD — Maine State Fair Association president Richard Carroll Smith, 59, of Litchfield died Saturday at a hospital in Augusta, of injuries received in a fall from a week earlier.

He was born in Gardiner, the son of Fred Linwood and Lillian Balkam Toothaker Smith. A graduate of Gardiner High School in 1944, he then served two years in the Navy. He worked with his father for three years and then helped manage the Jacques Turkey Ranch in Litchfield until 1951.

In 1960, he became president of the Litchfield Farmers Club and that same year was named town manager in Litchfield, holding that position until 1982. During his tenure, he also served the town as road commissioner, tax collector, treasurer, welfare agent, registrar of voters, town clerk and constable.

He was a communicant of Christ Church Episcopal in Gardiner, for which he served two terms on the vestry and on numerous committees.

In 1967, he was one of the three co-founders of the Tacoma Realty Company of Gardiner. Other activities included representing Litchfield on the Southern Kennebec Planning Commission and the school planning commission.

During the bicentennial in 1975-76, he was chairman of the Litchfield Bi-centennial committee.

Most recently, he had been active in the Cursillo movement, and with the Marriage Encounter movement.

He is survived by his wife, Fay Elizabeth Jacques Smith of Litchfield, whom he married in 1948; three sons, Danny D. Smith and

PITTSFIELD — Roderic "Rod" L. Smith, 87, died Oct. 3 at his home.

He was born in Colrain, Mass., a son of D. Leon and Sarah Davis Smith. He graduated from Turners Falls High School, Deerfield Academy and Springfield College, all in Massachusetts. He played baseball and soccer and was captain of both teams at Springfield College. In 1958 he received a master's degree in education from the University of Maine.

He taught at Montpelier Seminary/Vermont Junior College from 1938 to 1940 and at Ricker Classical Institute, Houlton from 1940 to 1945. From 1945 until his retirement in 1972, he was teacher and athletic director at Maine Central Institute here. He also coached several sports there, including baseball and soccer.

He had been involved in semi-professional baseball teams in Montpelier and Newport, Vt. Upon moving to Pittsfield he continued as manager and player for the Pittsfield ACs from 1944 to 1952.

For 13 years he was summer director of the Kiwanis swimming program.

During the late 1950s he and Mike Loeb, a former Colby College athletic director, introduced the game of soccer to independent schools in Maine.

Mr. Smith was a charter member of the First Congregational Church of Pittsfield. She was also a member of the Maine State and Retired Maine State Teachers associations, the National Education Association and the Monument Lodge, Houlton.

He was involved in organizing the Central Maine Coaches and Officials Board, as well as the Athletic Directors Board of the Maine Association of Independent Schools.

He received a certificate of award from the Kennebec Valley Athletic Conference for work to improve interscholastic athletics in Maine. In 1994 he was elected into the Maine Central Institute Hall of Fame.

His interests included his family, the New York Yankees and golfing. He was a fisherman and went on many fishing excursions with his late son-in-law, Jeffrey Norris, and other former M.C.I. students.

Surviving are his wife of 60 years, Persis Carr Smith of Pittsfield; three daughters, Mrs. Peter (Sally) Bryant of South Hampton, N.H., Mrs. Richard (Judith) Chapman of South Glastonbury, Conn., and Susan Norris of Pittsfield; and seven grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 4 p.m. Friday at the First Congregational Church, Park Street. Arrangements are by Shorey Funeral Chapel.

"Those GI guys did a lot to get an education," Mrs. Smith recalls. He graduated with praise in 1950 and followed that with a year of graduate work.

From 1955 to 1959 he was an interviewer and counselor in the Maine State Employment Office in Lewiston. In 1959, he and his wife purchased the IGA grocery store on Route 26 in Poland. Mrs. Smith recalls buying the store as a "crazy idea," but her husband learned a lot from the experience. "It's not a bad living — if you want to work 90 hours a week."

After selling the business in 1963, he returned to the State Employment Office and, with his wife and a friend, also ran King & Smith Realty.

In 1966 he went to the administrative office of the Maine State Employment Commission in Augusta, where he was assistant director and, subsequently, director. He retired in 1980.

He enjoyed fishing, hunting, and traveling with his Airstream trailer. In 1988 he and Mrs. Smith traveled 14,000 miles in four months to Alaska and back, towing the trailer.

He was a member of Masonic Orders of Dunlap Council, Lewiston Commandary Bradford Chapter, Ashlar Lodge and Kora Shrine. He was also a member of the White Mountains, N.H., Unit WBCCL.

A granddaughter, Sarah Agren, died in 1989.

Surviving, besides his wife, are two daughters, Tina Agren of Auburn and Jean Smith-Bernier of Kauai, Hawaii; and three grandsons, Eric and Jason Agren and Matthew Bernier.

He donated his body to the University of New England College of Osteopathic Medicine.
