Pittsfield, March 20—Neil D. Stanley, 48, former president of the Maine Pomological Society, for several years proprietor of the Stanley Orchards in this town and prominent in Masonic circles, died at his home here late Tuesday night, following a long illness.

Mr. Stanley was born at Porter, spent a part of his boyhood at Palmyra, and has been a resident of this town for about 25 years. He was for several years employed as shipping clerk at the Waverly Mill, and since that time had been owner and proprietor of the prosperous orchard farm, where he has specialized in raising high grade apples for the market.

For the last two or three years he had been employed as a salesman for the Elmore Feed Company, covering a large territory in the State.

He was particularly interested in Masonry, and was a hard worker in the various branches of this organization. He was worshipful master of Meridian Lodge of Pittsfield in 1926, high priest of Ira Berry Chapter of Pittsfield in 1921, worthy patron of Bethlehem Chapter, O. E. S. of Pittsfield in 1921 and 1922, and commander of St. Omar Commandery, Knights Templar of Waterville in 1933-34. He was a member of Mount Moriah Council of Skowhegan and of the Maine Consistory.

The surviving relatives are his wife, A. Florence Keene Stanley; four children, Eleanor, Barbara and Herbert Stanley, and Mrs. Katherine Hanson all of Pittsfield; his mother, Mrs. Florence Hall who has lived with the family for the last two years; his father, T. A. Stanley of East Woodstock, Conn., and a sister, Mrs. R. A. Bass of Waltham, Mass.

Funeral services will be conducted at the Universalist Church Friday at 2 p. m. with a special service by Meridian Lodge. The body will be placed in the tomb for burial in the village cemetery in the Spring.

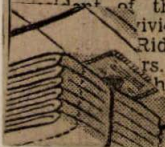
Orman L. Stanley, 64, former State Senator and State Representative and prominent in business and political circles, died suddenly at his home on Main Street Wednesday night after an illness of 10 days.

Mr. Stanley, originator of the plan to organize the Kezar Falls National Bank, instituted in 1910, has been cashier of the bank since then and was also vice president of the bank.

Born in the Porter section of Kezar Falls Dec. 14, 1876, son of Preston J. and Naomi Stacy Stanley, he was graduated from Parsonsfield Seminary and taught school in Porter for two years and was superintendent five years. He was Kezar Falls postmaster from 1903 to 1913 and conducted a dry goods store for several years. He was treasurer of the Oxford Land and Lumber Company of Kezar Falls and member of Stanley Brothers, undertakers. In addition to being superintendent of schools from 1900 to 1905, he was a member of the school board for 25 years and moderator at town meetings for 25 years. He was a member of the Legislature in 1909 and of the Senate in 1917 and 1919. He was a member of Governor William Tudor Gardiner's Executive Council from 1929 to 1933.

Mr. Stanley was a lifelong Republican, a 32nd degree Mason and member of the Shrine, Knights of Pythias, Red Men and Kezar Falls Kiwanis Club, having been first president of the Kiwanis Club.

Survived by his widow, Mrs. Ridlon Stanley; three sons, Lloyd Locke of Bridgton, Daniel Leonard of New York, and Harry Wishman of Kezar Falls. The son, Malcolm, of
