Retired U.S. Army Col. Charles L. Stephenson, 90, formerly of Basin Point, Harpswell, and Brunswick and former Cumberland County director of civil defense, died yesterday in Seaside Nursing and Retirement Home.

Born in New Rochelle, N.Y., he was the son of Joseph B. and Jennie Middleton Stephenson. He attended schools there and in Great Barrington, Mass. He graduated from the University of Maine and attended Harvard Graduate School.

During the 1930s, he was a district superintendent of schools in several Massachusetts school districts and was active in implementing the consolidation of rural school districts.

He was a Mason, an original member of the Lodge of Orono, and a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Brunswick.

His first wife, Dorris Wilkins Stephenson, died in 1958.

He is survived by his wife, Margaret Carpenter Stephenson; two sons, Dr. Richard B. Stephenson of Portland and Dr. John L. Stephenson of Garrett Park, Md.; six grandchildren and a great-grandchild.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. tomorrow at Stetson Funeral Home, 12 Federal St., Brunswick. The Rev. Donald Nickerson Jr. will officiate and burial will be in West Harpswell Cemetery.

#### WHAT U. S. WANTS

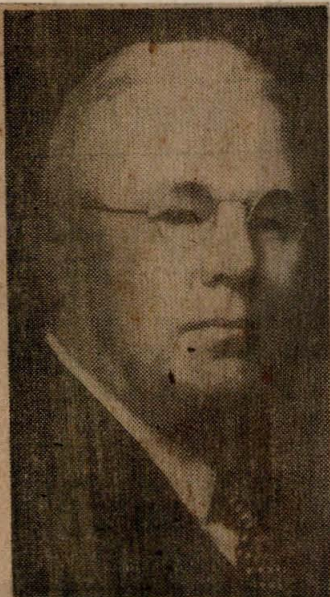
Dulles told a news conference the United States is in favor of a summit meeting and wants preparations for it that will lead to substantial achievements for peace.

But this country, he said, wants no part of any fraud or hoax which would merely fool people. Dulles said the great danger in the present East-West debate over summit meeting is that the Soviets want to substitute the fiction that the cold war has ended for the reality of the cold war.

#### EES NO ACCORD

Dulles declared flatly that at present he knows of no major issues which in the light of known Soviet and Western positions offered any likelihood of agreement at a summit conference.

But, Dulles continued, this does not mean prospects are hopeless because some possibilities of agreement may be opened up by careful and substantial work in advance of a summit meeting. He described the U. S. position in approaching East-West talks as flexible.

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## DR. RUFUS E. STETSON

DAMARISCOTTA — Dr. Rufus E. Stetson, 81, a pioneer in the field of blood transfusion and hematology and an overseer emeritus of Bowdoin College, died Monday in Washington, D.C.

He was born here Aug. 10, 1886, son of Dr. Edward F. and Mary Chapman Stetson.

He was graduated from Lincoln Academy in 1904, from Bowdoin College in 1908 and from the College of Physicians and Surgeons, Columbia University in 1911.

Dr. Stetson practiced until 1941 when he returned to his hometown, but not to retire.

In addition to his private practice here, he was chief of staff of the Miles Memorial Hospital. In 1958, Bowdoin College awarded him the honorary degree of doctor of science.

He was a member of the American Medical Association, the New York State Medical Society, the Maine Medical Society, the Lincoln County Medical Association, the board of overseers of Bowdoin College, Lincoln Academy trustees and Alna Lodge, AF & AM.

Surviving besides his wife, Mrs. Erma Tierney Stetson, are three sons, Edwin of Bethesda, Md. and Camden, William W. of Arlington, Va. and Damariscotta and Rufus E. Jr. of Wiscasset; two sisters, Mrs. Victor Blake of Warwick, N.Y. and Mrs. Rex Dodge of Falmouth Foreside; 11 grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 3 p.m. Friday at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, Newcastle.

Bowdoin will be represented at the service by Prof. Athern P. Daggett, the college's acting president, and by members of Bowdoin's governing boards.

The American flag on the college's Memorial Flagpole was lowered to half staff in memory of Dr. Stetson.

Prof. Daggett said in a statement:

"A loyal son of the College, a devoted member of the Governing Boards, and for over a score of years a cherished neighbor, Dr. Stetson will be sorely missed by all the members of the Bowdoin family. His memory remains to hearten and inspire us."
