

U.S. Lighthouse kept



William A. Stevens, retired lighthouse construction foreman, died today in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Harriet L. Bangert, 44 Beech Street, South Portland, after an illness of a week. He would have been 94 years next Wednesday.

In the service of the U. S. Lighthouse department half a century when he was retired Aug. 20, 1922, Mr. Stevens for 45 years supervised construction and repairs of lighthouses from Calais and Eastport to the Massachusetts east coast at Vineyard Haven. Portland Head Light was one of the lights in his care. Many of his building and repair jobs involved bodily risks.

Born in London, England, March 1, 1850, Mr. Stevens came to the United States in 1862 at the age of 12 years. His brother, the late George Stevens, had preceded him and wrote so interestingly of his new home country that Mr. Stevens followed, making the trip on the Proprius in the then short voyage of 17 days.

Settling first at Ferry Beach, South Portland, he then shipped as a cabin boy, abandoning this work for a job on a South Windham farm. There he later married Miss Harriet F. Bragdon of that town, and they had been married nearly 65 years when she died in July, 1936. Joining the lighthouse service in 1872, he served continuously until he was retired 22 years ago.

He was a member of Hiram Lodge, AF&AM, South Portland; the National Association of Federal Employees, the Maine Charitable Mechanics Association, the Three Quarter Century Club and the Mount Pleasant Cemetery Association, South Portland.

Surviving besides Mrs. Bangert, with whom he had made his home several years, are two other daughters, Mrs. Lillian Jordan and Mrs. Ella Loveitt, also of South Portland, eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. Sunday in the home of Mrs. Loveitt, 344 Preble Street, South Portland, and interment will be in the family lot in Mount Pleasant Cemetery. Masonic rites will be conducted in connection with the services.


