Kingfield, June 2.—Horace Greeley Winter, widely known president of H. G. Winter and Sons, one of the two largest woodturning concerns in New England, died Sunday in his Main Street residence on his 74th birthday, after a brief illness.

Born at Freeman, June 1, 1873, son of Ira S. F. and Harriet Williamson Winter, he became president of the woodturning concern in 1924. He also was president of the Kingfield Bank, the Kingfield Company and a former president of the National Association of woodturners.

An active member of the Republican Party, he was a member of the Maine Legislature from 1939 to 1941.

Mr. Winter had been appointed both ev-Gov. Sumner Sewall and Gov. Horace A. Hildreth's Building Committee of the State Building at the Eastern State Prison at Springfield, Mass. He was a trustee of Franklin County Memorial Hospital and with H. G. Winter of Kingfield, contributed the money for building the Nursing Home hospital, which was named the Winter Hall in his honor.

Besides holding many town offices, Mr. Winter was a member of the Temple Shrine, and a 32nd degree Mason. He attended the Baptist Church.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Erma Hutchins Winter; a sister, Mrs. Harry Ransom, Springfield, Mass.; a son, Harold S. Winter, Kingfield, and five grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Wednesday in his residence. Interment will be in Sunnyside Cemetery.

ENGLEWOOD, Fla. — Burton Brooks Witham Sr., 95, longtime custodian of Portland's Kotzschmar Memorial Organ and a leader in the Masons, died here Jan. 17.

Mr. Witham was a pipe-organ technician for most of his working career. For 41 years he was custodian of the Kotzschmar Organ at Portland City Hall Auditorium.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

When the auditorium received its most recent facelift in 1968, Mr. Witham uprooted all 6,518 pipes, had many of them retooled and then rebuilt the organ system just a few yards from where it was previously. Dedicated in 1914, the Kotzschmar Organ was the first municipal organ in the United States.

Mr. Witham repaired and installed pipe organs in churches and college halls across Maine and New Hampshire, and he was friends with many members of the clergy.

"That was his trade," said his son, Burton Jr. "His main clientele was churches."

Mr. Witham's friendship with members of the clergy led to some confusion in 1960 when he went in for surgery at Maine Medical Center. According to a Press Herald story, his nurses became puzzled when clergymen of a variety of faiths gathered in his room all week, until he explained his occupation.

Mr. Witham was not a musician, but he enjoyed the results of his work. "He approached his job from a technical angle," said his son. "He could play a few chords and a couple of pieces, but he was not an organist. He wouldn't have anything to do with an electronic organ. As far as he was concerned, the tonal quality wasn't the same as a pipe organ."

He and his wife, Celia Smart Witham, lived at 389 Main St. in Westbrook for many years before moving to Gray Road, Gorham. He was a member of the Gorham First Parish Congregational Church and an associate member of Englewood United Methodist Church.

He was a high priest and a past master in the Eagle Chapter of the Royal Arch Masons, and a past master of the Temple Masonic Lodge in Westbrook. He and his wife were grand patron and matron of the Order of the Amaranth in Maine, which is that organization's highest position in the state.

Born in Westbrook, a son of Dr. A.N. and Mary Pennell Witham, he was president of his class at Westbrook Seminary (now Westbrook College) in Portland.

Mrs. Witham died in 1979, and Mr. Witham retired in 1980 and moved to Florida.

Surviving are his son, Capt. Burton B. Jr., Navy (Ret.), of Englewood; two granddaughters and three great-granddaughters.

A service was held in Florida, and burial will be in the spring in Woodlawn Cemetery, Westbrook. Arrangements are by Hay Funeral Home, Westbrook.

Weld, Oct. 4.—Clyde H. Witham, 1, former Rumford chiropractor, was found dead today on the Mount Blue Trail about a mile from the Old Home Place here. The body was found by Deputy Sheriff Herschel P. Boynton and Maurice Kennedy of Farmington, members of a large posse which included Game Warden Mendall Conant of Weld, Donald McKeen and Joe Moore, East Wilton and several Weld residents.

Dr. George L. Pratt, Farmington medical examiner, returned a verdict of suicide by shooting. Sheriff Earl R. Hawkens of Farmington said the act was committed with a .45 calibre revolver as Witham lay between two large rocks on the side of the mountain. He left his car near the Old Home Place which aided searchers in finding the body.
