"My brother was meticulous. He didn't like the idea of (utility) poles sticking up, so there is not a pole standing out here," Mr. Wright's brother said Saturday from Two Lights Terrace.

In 1979, after the last Two Lights Terrace home site was sold, Mr. Wright remodeled as his home the 115-year-old chief lighthouse keeper's house, about 35 feet from the lighthouse, which remains active today.

said Mr. Wright was a 32nd degree Mason, belonging to the Hiram Lodge and the Kora Shrine Club of Greater Portland.

"He was completely devoted to his lodge work, and he never married, so he could be quite generous with his time," said Mr. Wright's brother, adding that Mr. Wright endowed a lodge scholarship fund for South Portland and Cape Elizabeth students to continue their education after high school.

Mr. Wright wanted to be known as a man of integrity. "His word was good, and if he gave it you could count on it," his brother said.

As a youth, Mr. Wright attended South Portland

schools and worked part time and summers for about 10 years in the greenhouses of J.W. Minott Co. florists. He graduated with a degree in civil engineering from the University of Maine in 1951 and attended graduate school at Bates College.

He founded Petroleum Equipment of Maine and served as its president until the business was sold in 1978. From 1940 until shortly before his death, Mr. Wright helped manage his family's real estate and investment interests.

He is survived by his brother and his sister, Elizabeth Maines of Huntsville, Ala.

KENNEBUNK, March 30. (Special.)—Edwin S. Wright, a veteran of the Civil War and the last surviving charter member of Riverside Lodge, K. of P., died at his home on Storer street, aged 83 years. 


